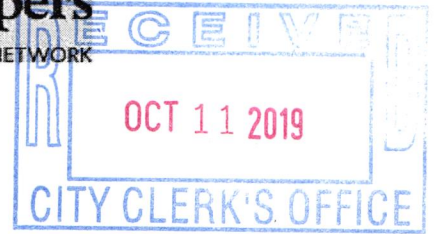

The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, pursuant to City Code Sections 22-75, 22-76, and 22-143 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Pierce, will on Monday, October 21, 2019 hold a Public Hearing in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida, at their meeting which begins at 6:30 p.m., to consider the following:

1. Review and approval of an application for Conditional Use with New Construction & Design Review submitted by Property Owners, Anne Supina & Sandra Twoey, & Representative, Architectonic Inc, to construct a single family home seaward (east) of the Coastal Construction Control Line (CCCL), located at 1912 Surfside Drive in Fort Pierce, FL. The property is zoned Single Family Low Density (R-1) Parcel ID: 2412-501-0121-000-3.

2. Review and approval of an application for Conditional Use with New Construction & Design Review submitted by Property Owner, Surfside Equities, LLC, & Representative, Braden & Braden, to construct a single family home seaward (east) of the Coastal Construction Control Line (CCCL), located at 1814 Surfside Drive in Fort Pierce, FL.
