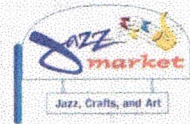

Dear Recipient:

For the health and safety of our patrons, visitors, vendors and community the Fort Pierce Farmers Market Resolves to take the following actions when returning to Marina Square in Fort Pierce.

Precautions and Countermeasures;

1. Ensure that all vendor tents have 10 feet of space on both sides. This will give us adequate space between vendors.
2. Temporarily lower the amount of vendors to be hosted at the market to ensure we have enough space to accomplish vendor distancing.
3. Temporarily put a hold on bands. This will discourage people from congregating in one space.
4. Designate one way vendor isles to encourage social distancing.
5. Set up as many vendors on the seawall as possible to discourage patrons from congregating in that area
6. Encourage the use of hand sanitizer in strategic locations at the market.
7. Put out signs encouraging patrons to wear masks and observe social distancing guidelines.
8. Require all vendors wear masks and gloves at all times.
9. Require vendors have and use hand sanitizer at their tents.



JAZZ MARKET RE-OPEN GUIDELINES

June 5, 2020

01. 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM
02. Max of 60 Tents out of possible 94
03. Each tent is 10' X 10'
04. There shall be two, (2), feet between each tent. This dictates larger distance between vendors/customers.
05. Collection of money shall be done with a device with no one touching or handling the money with hand to hand contact. Rules that should be followed utilizing credit card payments:
 - a. Avoid touching your face afterward.
 - b. Avoid placing payment directly in anyone's hands; instead, set it down on the counter or on a provided tray of some sort.
 - c. Disinfect any surfaces that the money or cards have touched as well as keypads, cash registers and payment terminals.
06. All Vendors are required to wear masks.
07. All Vendors are required to provide hand sanitizer stations at their tented space.
08. One Entrance / One Exit These will be monitored with an appointee of the Market Manager.

09. Temperatures of all involved, vendors and patrons will be monitored by person at entrance using the new Thermal Detection no touch forehead thermometers. We have 2 of these devices.
10. June ?? – Oct 1, 2020
11. Parking for all should be directed to one of the 2 garages available. Orange Ave and 2nd Street. There should be some sort of shuttle service between both garages and BOTH markets, Green/Farmers Market and Jazz Market.
12. Signage for parking would help direct cars to park in the City Garages. Shuttle signage would encourage people to go to the City Garages. Shuttle service must be in place before this would become a reality. There could be a .50 cent charge for the shuttle if cost is a factor. That would also fund this service with driver/insurance and help, long term, with the cost off the shuttle itself.

This program is designed for **recommended** music students that don't have financial resources; to provide weekly music events, (jams), which provides jazz/blues and all types of music to the public at little or no cost to the public; we provide the very camaraderie amongst the local community during these weekly events that we are known for; we provide special musical events at an affordable cost at the Black Box and/or elsewhere; etc..., There is a very long list of accomplishment that make up the DNA of the Ft Pierce Jazz & Blues Society. We are very proud of our achievements over the years and we are, probably, one of the most community minded organizations on the Treasure Coast.
