WHEREAS, Commissioner Sessions is one of the founders of the local Police Athletic League (PAL), and has served as a member of multiple city and county boards including, the Retirement Board, Lincoln Park Main Street, St. Lucie County Transportation Planning Organization, the Sunrise Theatre Advisory Board, the Treasure Coast Education, Research & Development Authority and the St. Lucie County Fire Board; and
