Re: Body Worn Camera (BWC) Investigation (Presented to City Commission of Fort Pierce on November 16, 2020).

In an effort to be both fair to the FPPD, and through in my research, before proposing an ordinance regulating FPPD BWC, I reviewed documents provided in response to my request.

I further met with Assistant Chief Kenny Norris and City Manager Nic Mimms on September 14, 2020, because it represented to me the FPPD did not understand the nature of 2 or my 3 my requests for documents.

I requested three sets of documents. Only **only request one in part** has been provided.

1. **BWC Monthly Compliance Reports.** Policy and Procedure 83.130 I.9.a. and b. (Provided in part.) (See analysis attached.)
2. BWC recording and data **audits.** Policy and Procedure 83.130 I.2. (**Not provided.**)
3. BWC Program and Policy Reviews Policy and Procedure 83.130 N. (both annual and as needed reports) (**Not provided.**)

Feigning ignorance about my request, when my request cited the specific section, paragraph and subparagraph which refers to these documents, indicated to me an intent to evade providing these documents or the documents did not exist. I found the latter to be true upon meeting with the aforementioned.

A claimed set of **Monthly Compliance Reports** was provided with 936 review entries. **BUT**, I was not provided with the documentation in regard to “notifications via the chain-of-command are made when a departmental concern is discovered.”
Discovered.

In regard to the **BWC Recording And Data Audits** not provided, an excuse given is that the audits requested need to be redacted. The audits, if in fact they exist, should not need to be redacted. All the data to determine compliance can be put in the audit.

Any claimed exempt or confidential data can be put in an appendix. If taken at their word about redaction, this indicates at best, the design of the audits prevents transparency. At worst, it indicates the possibility that program non-compliance may be being concealed. It also raises the question as to the FPPD’s compliance with statutory body camera requirements under Section 943.1718(2) and (3) Florida Statutes.

BWC Program and Policy Reviews were not provided. “The BWC Program and this policy will be reviewed annually or more frequently as needed.” There should be no need of redaction of these documents. Nor delay in providing them. These documents, if they exist, will demonstrate whether any policy review on this vital subject have occurred.

I question whether any reviews have occurred, when looking at the policy in section “O”. That section refers to a document, “I.A.C.P. National Law Enforcement Policy Center, Body Worn Cameras, April 2014”. That reference is 5 years out of date. The latest I.A.C.P. document is dated April 2019.

I brought this matter to the Commission’s attention in June, over three months ago. Yet, full, candid, and promptly produced documents, have not been produced. Citizen lives, police lives, and taxpayers’ dollars are at stake. I need this information.

Re: Police Reports

Police reports that are indicative of major issues regarding failure to file appropriate reports as opposed to incident reports. By nature on the onset upon completing is a problem;

Reasons:

1. Don't get the priority in investigations.
2. An appearance of low crime that does not get reported, when crime is actually happening in the City of Fort Pierce.
3. No serious consideration is given for rewarding of grants to obtain Police Officers from the Federal Government.
4. Could potentially lead to city liability if a third part relies on the crime rate as indicated. However, it's misleading and ultimately could become the product of a civil law suit.

Understanding UCR – and why it's important for grants

One common problem law enforcement grant seekers have with applying for most federal grants is that you are required to have submitted Uniform Crime Report (UCR) data for the past three years in order to be eligible to receive a grant.

As a grant person, you may not understand UCR, although you have most likely heard of it. While law enforcement agencies are not required to submit any data to the FBI, every agency is encouraged to do so. The information is published in the annual “Crime in the United States” report.

In all but four states (Indiana, Mississippi, New Mexico and parts of Ohio), law enforcement agencies submit their annual data to a state UCR program. It’s these departments that review, analyze and validate the data received before sending it along to the FBI. As with many things, every state does this process a little differently, and some require even more information than the FBI does.

If your agency does submit UCR data annually, you are good to go for these federal opportunities. This includes most, if not all, Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) grants.

So why is it important to submit UCR data if it’s not mandatory? The reasons not to do it make a lot of sense. Compiling this type of data is difficult, time-consuming and fraught with issues. Small agencies may not have the resources to accomplish it, and even larger agencies with great data collecting capabilities find it to be cumbersome and difficult to manage.

BUT — You probably won’t be able to get a federal grant without it.

Unfortunately for agencies that haven't yet set up a UCR data collection system, the effort it takes to compile UCR data can be onerous. It's not just a matter of adding up the numbers by crime type because the elements that make up UCR crimes are very specific.

There is hierarchy to the crimes (Part I and Part II), and only one crime can be counted for each reported incident, which defaults to the highest one on the scale. Each crime type must meet specific criteria that most likely won't match your state's statutory definitions, so your internal data won't match up to UCR data.

The basic elements that make up the definitions for each crime, and the crimes that are counted, have changed very little since the system was first developed in 1929, although the FBI is currently undertaking a redevelopment of the system. Arson was added a number of years ago (it's the only one that can be used as a second crime in a given incident), hate crimes have also been included in the overall data collection and, just recently, changes were made to the characteristics that constitute rape. UCR data also includes clearance rates and there is a separate report on law enforcement officers injured or killed.

Interestingly, the FBI clearly discourages using the published UCR data to rank or compare crime rates across jurisdictions, since the resultant numbers are just that and don't take into account a number of factors that would enable you to compare cities in an apples-to-apples fashion. Of course, that doesn't stop a lot of people from doing just that. Despite its limitations, UCR does provide a year to year analysis of how each agency or jurisdiction is doing addressing its own crime issues.

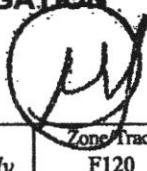
It's up to the administration of your agency whether or not you submit annual data for UCR, but understanding that not doing so limits your ability to apply for federal grants may be a starting point for further consideration.

On 02/07/2019 at approximately 2328 hours, I responded to N 29th Street and Avenue I Fort Pierce in reference to shooting activity.

Upon my arrival, I began canvassing the area in reference to the call. I was then flagged down at [REDACTED] by a black male subject (later identified as [REDACTED] advised that his house and two vehicles were struck by bullets. [REDACTED] stated, while in his room, he heard the sound of several shots being fired near his residence. [REDACTED] advised he then heard his fish tank, which is located in his living room, shatter and realized his residence was being shot at. Once the shooting ended, [REDACTED] stepped outside of his room and discovered bullet holes around the residence, his two vehicles, and a variety of casings located on the street directly in front of his residence. When questioned, [REDACTED] stated he did not hear or see anything further other than hearing the initial shots and flagged down the Police as they were canvassing. [REDACTED] wife (later identified as [REDACTED]) arrived on scene.

While speaking to [REDACTED] I observed several casings on the ground directly in front of the residence and bullet holes on both vehicles and residence. Several Officers arrived on scene, secured the scene and canvassed the area for witnesses and video footage with negative results. Crime scene arrived on scene to which photos were taken and the casings were collected.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] When questioned as to why this incident could have occurred, both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

During my investigation, I observed vehicle one (1999 tan in color Chevrolet SUV FL tag#[REDACTED]) to have bullet hole damages. The trunk, back right bumper panel, back right tire, right back passenger door, front right bumper panel, and front windshield were struck. Vehicle two (1995 black in color Chevrolet bearing FL tag#[REDACTED]) sustained bullet holes damages on the left back passenger window, right back passenger door, and the right front passenger door. While canvassing the area, I observed the residence to have been struck on the garage door, front windows, front door, and living room wall (facing west). Detective Simon arrived on scene and took over the investigation. Lt. Hall, Sgt. Lindstadt and Sgt. Palacio on scene.

BWC footage available. No further information to report.

SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT

On 05/18/2019 I responded to 1802 S US Highway 1 in reference to a disturbance with possible shots fired.

Upon arrival no one could be located in the parking lot of the motel. Officers canvassed the area and located two [REDACTED] shell casings in the south side parking lot along with a bullet fragment laying on the ground. Multiple bystanders were contacted in the area but no one claimed to have witnessed anything.

Contact was made with the owner of the motel, Hai Lin. Lin advised he did not see or hear any altercation take place but was able to pull surveillance footage of the area of the parking lot that the shell casings were found. Video footage shows around 1200 hours a large group of males and females in the parking lot arguing by a silver in color passenger car, possibly a Nissan. A black male wearing a black in color tee shirt is observed physically fighting with a black female wearing a tank top and shorts. The fight ensues between the male and female as onlookers attempt to separate the two. A black male wearing a white tee shirt with dreads then begins to fight with the male that is fighting with the female and restrains him. The male wearing the dark in color tee shirt then walks out of view of the camera.

At 1213 hours a red in color 4-door Toyota Camry pulls into the parking lot and three black males exit the vehicle. The male that exits the back seat of the vehicle appears to be the same male that was fighting with the female just prior. An argument between the three males and the large group that is with the female ensues and the male with the dark tee shirt walks to the Toyota. The male then opens the driver door of the vehicle and produces a handgun from the vehicle. The male then fires the gun possibly twice toward the crowd and everyone in the crowd takes off running. No one appeared to be hit by the gun fire.

The three males then get into the Toyota and drive away. It is unknown in the vehicle went north or south after leaving the motel parking lot.

A short time later the female that was involved in the altercation gets into the silver car along with two other passengers and leaves the motel as well.

At this time it is not believed that the parties involved in either group are staying at the motel and may have been visiting an unknown registered guest of the motel.

The camera footage is poor quality and did not produce clear images of and facial features or tag numbers on the vehicles.

The shell casings, bullet fragment and 2 CD-R's of photos and video footage were placed into evidence at the FPPD.

On 02/09/2019 Officers responded to the area of N 27th St and Ave D in reference to shooting activity.

The caller advised there were males on dirt bikes shooting.

Upon arrival shell casings were located in the 400 Block of N 27th St. Upon canvassing the area Officer Colvin met with the caller Tony Williams. Williams he saw a black male on a red dirt bike, wearing a dark green or gray hoodie with a black drawstring bookbag shooting at another male on a black dirt bike with yellow rims. The male was a black male with dreads wearing a black hoodie with a white hood. The male on the red bike rode off east and the other male went west on Dunbar from the scene.

Officer Paulvil made contact with Jacqueline Wayman who stated the same as Williams. Her description of the males are the following; black male, mid 20's with an unknown height riding the red bike who was shooting. The second male is described as a light skinned black male , mid 20's , thick dreads, black hoodie, black sweatpants with black Nike shoes approximately 5'7".

Upon arrival I made contact with [REDACTED] who stated she heard multiple gunshots outside her residence. [REDACTED] stated when she exited her residence, she observed her Silver Honda Civic ([REDACTED]) had been struck by the gunfire. [REDACTED] also stated her residence was struck twice, but that neither bullet had made entry in to the residence. INFORMATION REPORT

On 02/11/19 at approximately 1752 hours Officer Acevedo, Officer Lopez, Officer Adkins and myself were dispatched to 1411 North 25th Street in reference to a gunshot wound. Dispatch advised the victim was shot in the head.

Upon arrival, I observed the victim [REDACTED] sitting by the trunk of his vehicle (FL# [REDACTED] Mercury Grand Marquis and is white in color). He was holding the right side of his head and advised he had been shot. I did observe bleeding coming from the right side of his head (approximately 2 inches above his ear). I told dispatch it was OK to send in rescue. I asked the victim to tell me what happened. He advised he was by his car heard the multiple shots and ducked by his vehicle. He stated he never saw anyone or where the shots came from. He advised his ID was in his vehicle. Officer Acevedo located an envelope inside the passenger side of the vehicle with the victims name on it. I asked him if this is your name and current address on the envelope and he stated "yes". The victim continued to state, "Please do not let me die, please get me to a hospital."

SLCFR responded to the scene and transported the victim to LWRMC to be treated.

I did not observe any bullet holes to the victims vehicle or the apartment complex.

I then observed a witness [REDACTED] on the [REDACTED] I asked her if she saw anything. The following is a synopsis of the events told by the witness: I was [REDACTED] talking with the victim. Out of nowhere I heard multiple shots, I saw the victim dive by the side of his vehicle, to avoid being shot. I ran [REDACTED] I asked the witness if she saw anyone. She advised she saw nothing.

I did not observe any surveillance cameras at the apartment complex.

I then relocated to LWRMC and made contact with the victim. He was doing fine and advised the wound was a possible ricochet .

I then made contact with a physician and he advised the victim has a scratch or small abrasion and is ordering a cat scan to make sure no foreign objects made its way into the victims head. If the scans come back the victim will be released shortly.

Detective Feliu took over the investigation.
