b. Overview of the FPRA Incentive/Grant Program

Shyanne Helms provided an overview of the new FPRA Incentive/Grant Program. At the January 28, 2020 FPRA Board Meeting, the FPRA Board approved \$150,000 of FPRA contingency funding to create the following redevelopment incentives: Commercial Façade/Site Improvements Grants, Commercial Interior Improvement Grants, Small Business Grants and Event Sponsorship Grants. The CRA Advisory Committee will serve as the evaluation committee to rank each application before ultimately being decided upon by the FPRA Board. The CRA Advisory Committee will formulate the evaluation criteria at the next meeting.
