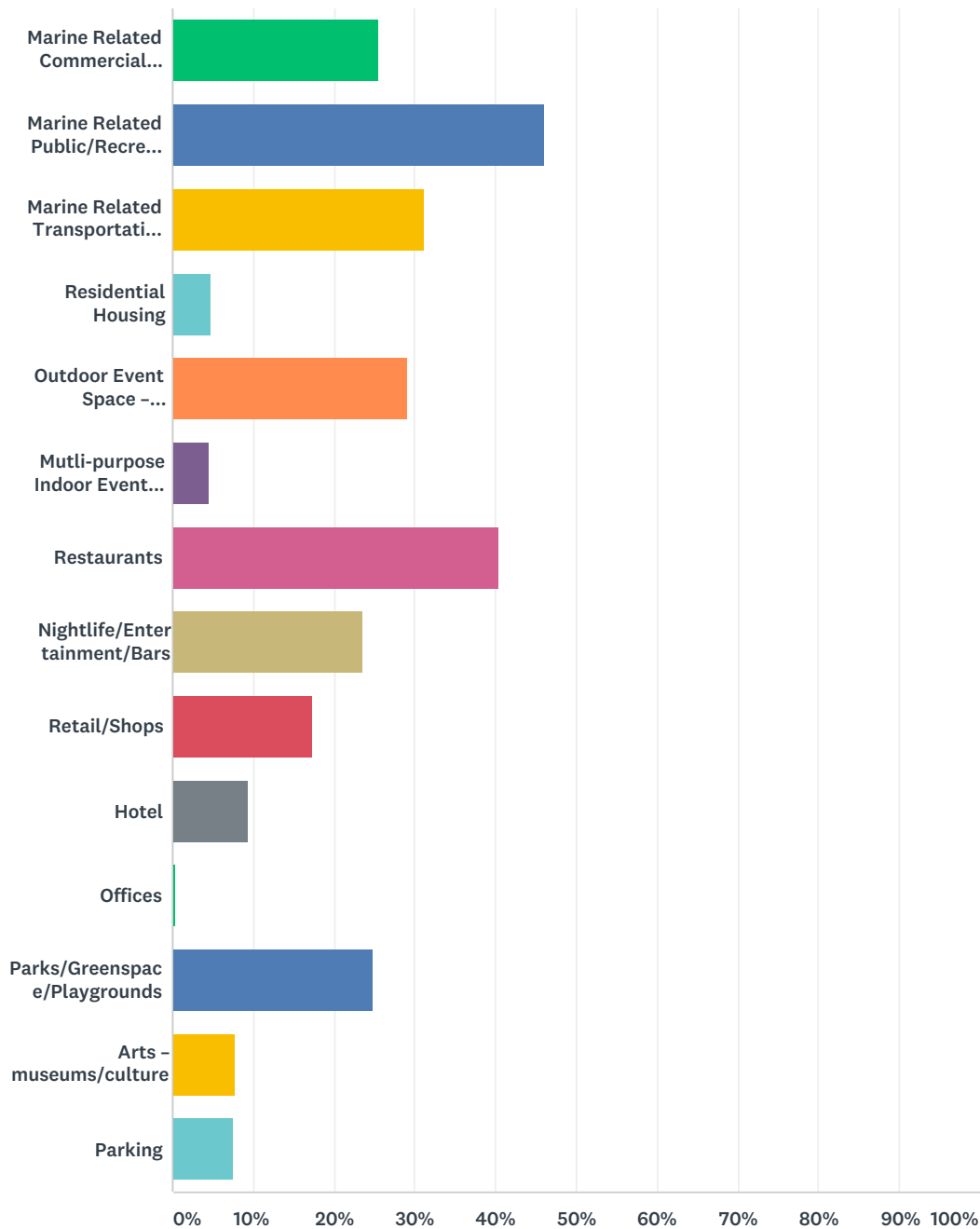


Q1 Which features would you like to see incorporated into the future development of Fisherman's Wharf? (Check top 3)

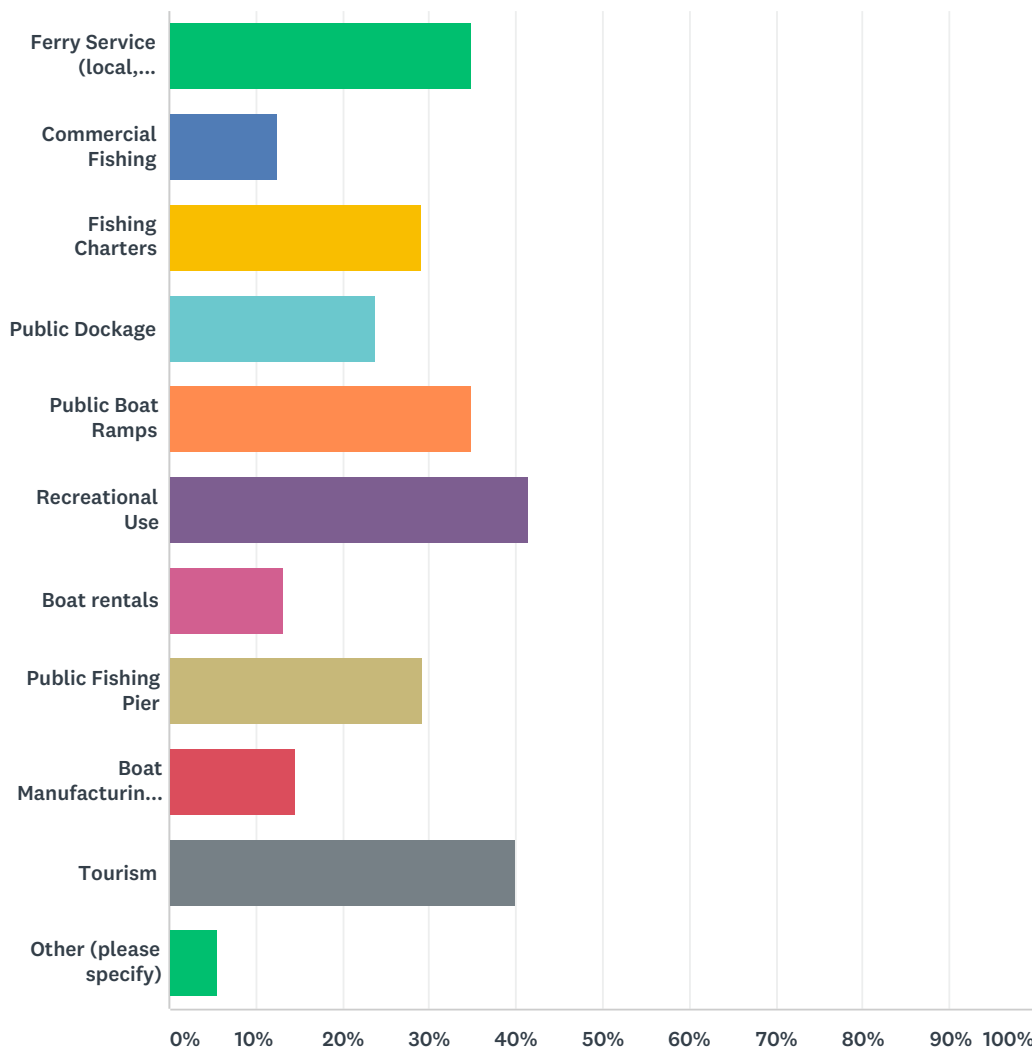

| 10 | Fisherman's Wharf is the "working waterfront" of Fort Pierce and a transitional area between the Port and Downtown. It is essential to maintain its unique character, separate from but connected to the historic Downtown and the waterfront and marine recreation destinations of the Causeway and Island. All activities co-located in this area should build on that unique commercial waterfront identity while connecting to and enhancing nearby uses. The items listed above are all potentially appropriate if implemented in the right scale with a thorough understanding of the market, the importance of maintaining district character and identity, and the role of the area in connecting the Port to the island and Downtown Fort Pierce. The district needs to feel clean and safe for the general public, while supporting the needs of marine industry and recreational water users. Multimodal connectivity is key. Walkability is essential. A grid of streets or walkways would add accessibility and functionality to the overall land area. Resources supporting businesses on the waterfront, in the Port, and in the Wharf area is appropriate. Marine industry-related offices and businesses, affordable breakfast and lunch options supporting employees, public spaces where residents and visitors can learn about Fort Pierce and St. Lucie County's marine (and rail) economy, and history are all healthy secondary uses supporting core commercial and recreational marine industry. Smaller-scale passive use event and green space would support activities within walking distance (for example, a playground and picnic space near a boat ramp). Large scale event space is potentially duplicative of Veteran's Park and Causeway Cove. This is also a possible location to relocate the St. Lucie Historical Museum and other attractions from Museum Point, creating an attraction with a connection to the existing long-term uses (marine and rail) in the area. A residence hotel or rental residences could be good support for crews staying in Fort Pierce while their vessels are being serviced at the Port. If the City is interested in pursuing a Water Taxi, Fisherman's Wharf could be a good "terminal" location for service to the State Park, Museum Point, and South Hutchinson Island. Given the existing Downtown entertainment district, new Nightlife/Entertainment/Bars are unnecessary, although some dining/drinking establishments and restaurants are essential to encourage evening activity and keep the area well lit and active at all times of day. A Multi-purpose Indoor Event Space, if larger than meeting and conference space currently available Downtown and in local hotels, could be helpful, but has limited potential to build on the authentic waterfront character of Fisherman's Wharf. | 10/29/2019 3:29 PM |

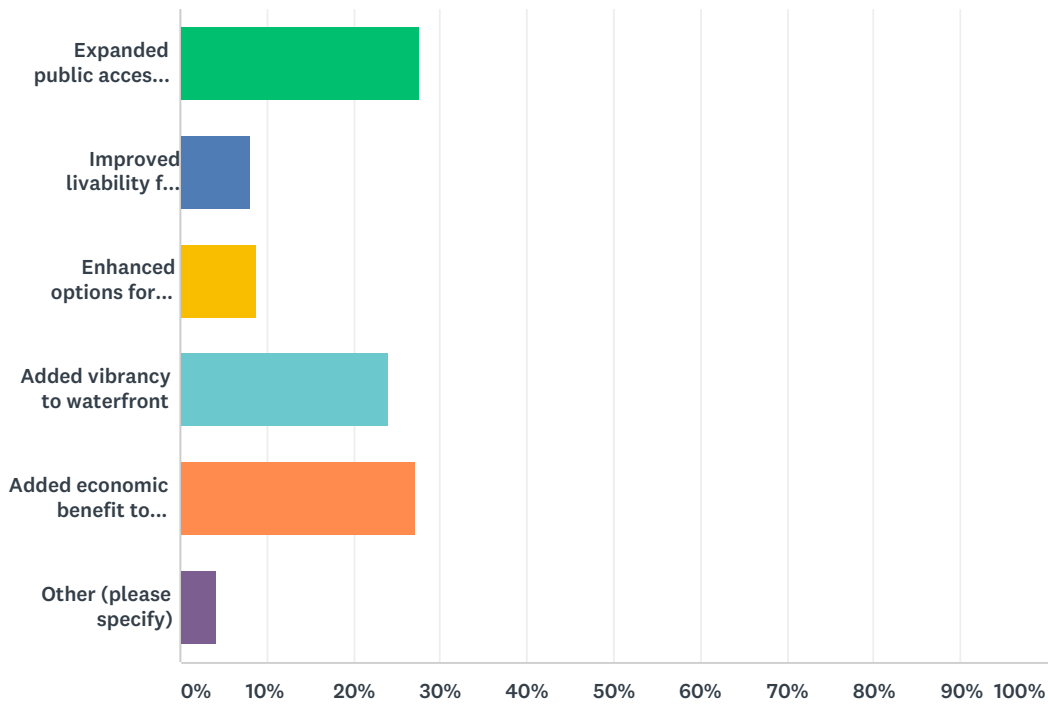

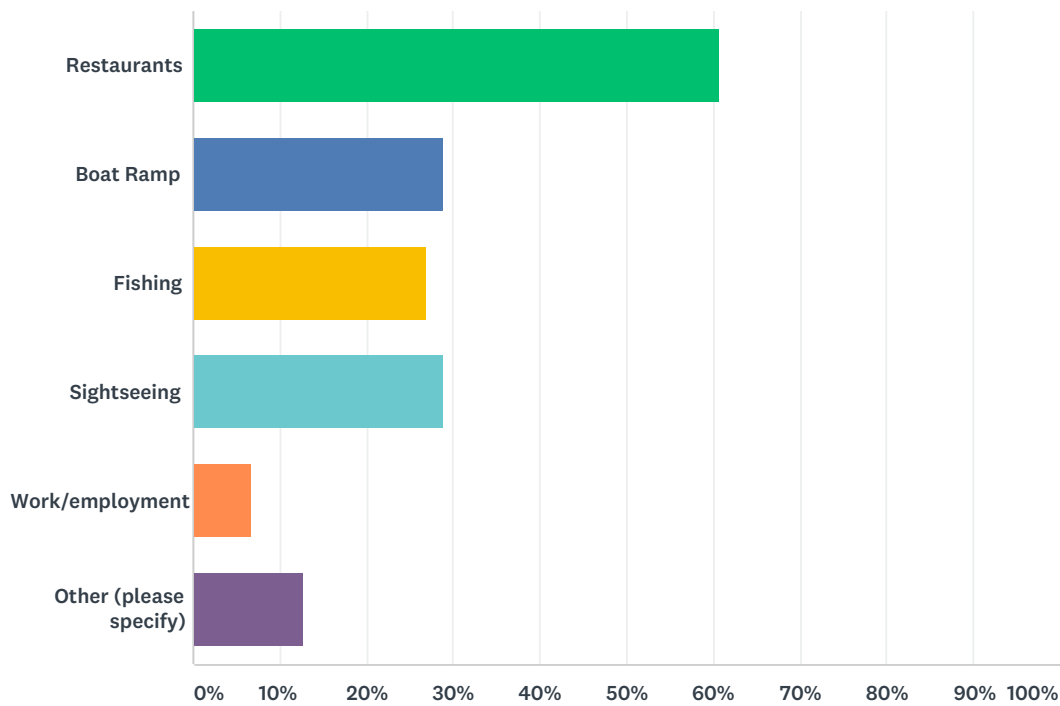

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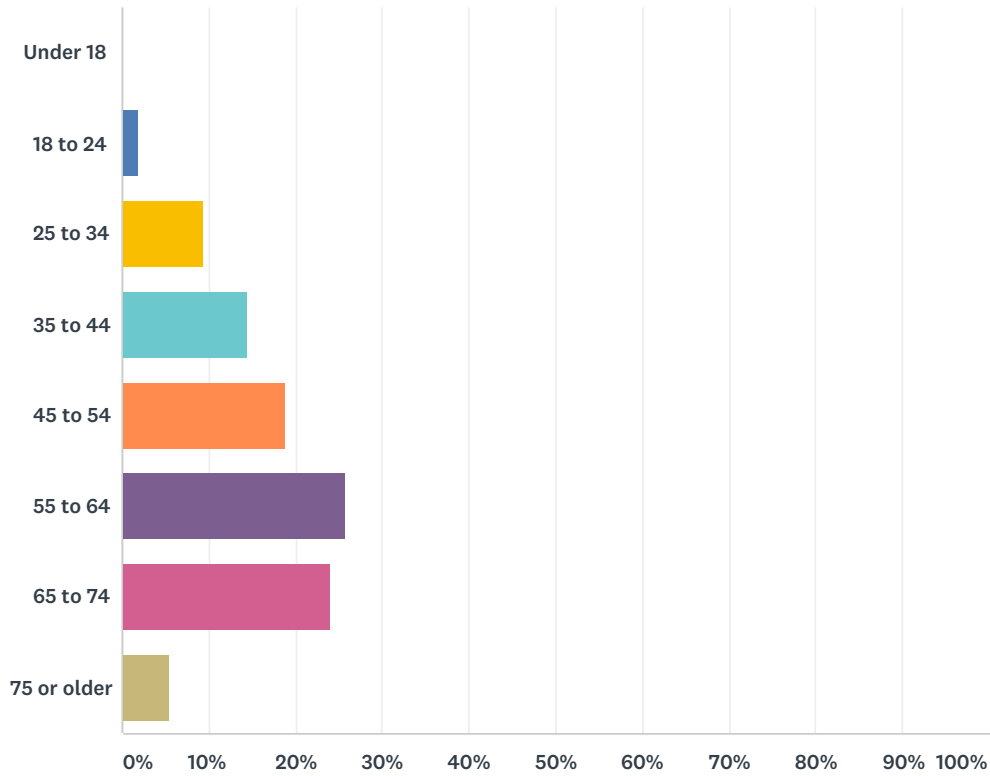

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Q7 What is your age?

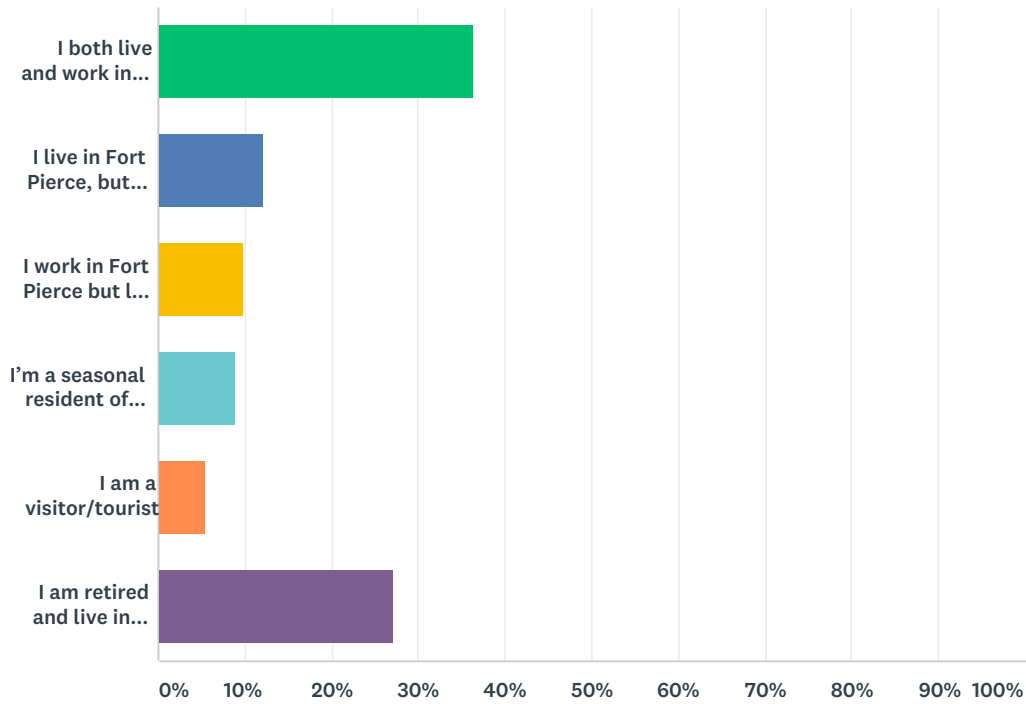

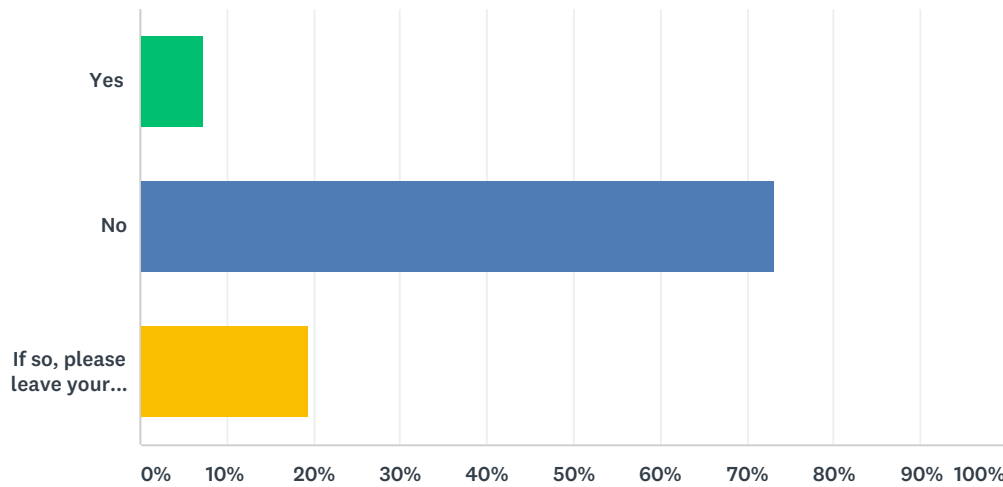
