# Parklet Business Owner data

- **Florida Hemp Collective**
  - Planned to open April, delayed to July. 3 months lost revenue
  - Using Parklet to engage community and educate on Hemp
- **Chic and Shore**
  - Sales are down slightly from last year
  - Parklet used as a waiting area for customers who want social distancing
  - Using to extend store items and host outside events
- **Hard Axe Lounge**
  - March 27 was planned opening, could not open until phase 2 on July 10<sup>th</sup>.
  - 4 months of lost revenue
  - Parklet has allowed us to partner with other fort pierce licensed businesses and come in space and attract more people and helped them as well.
- **Taco Dive**
  - Revenue is down 44% from same time last year
  - Parklets have allowed for eight additional seats, two tables.
  - Customers call and ask if we have outside seating, otherwise they won't come.
- **Subway**
  - Was not able to reach manager for information
- **Notions and Potions**
  - Had outside events in parklet, example artist painting.
  - Can account for 22 new customers because of Parklet
  - Sales up from last year in part to having parklet program.
- **Delicious**
  - Opened in December
  - Had to do delivery only because of Covid, so lost revenue for in house sales.
  - Parklet has allowed us to have between 2 and 4 tables for customers who don't want to eat inside.
  - Many customers still don't want to eat inside.
- **Beach Bowls**
  - Opened during Covid.
  - Parklet has allowed for outside space where customers can sit outside and enjoy food.
- **Braford Steak House**
  - Was not able to reach manager for information
- **Rooster in Garden**
  - Was not able to reach manager for information
- **Public House**
  - Had to close with no business for 9 months, lost revenue.
  - Parklet allows for customers to enjoy music outside in a socially distance way. Many customers don't want to be inside still.

# Ideas

- Allow current Parklet to continue through season.
  - Understanding if there is a Christmas parade, all current parklets will be removed and put back up after the parade.
- Setup a Parklet Permit program, let the existing ones sign up for it.
  - A reasonable fee.
  - Current outdoor café permit for other table is \$50 a year.
- Roving Parklet program- this has been suggested but is not feasible with the way many of the parklets have been setup.
