LPM Technical Services Inc. (LPMTS) was tasked by Overhead Door of America to provide wind pressures for the above referenced facility located at 721 Avenue D, Fort Pierce, FL 34950. The following information was provided via as-built (legacy) plans and Overhead Door of America:

1. Building Length = 80.00 feet
2. Building Width = 47.33 feet
3. Roof Type = Hipped
4. Soffit overhang = 4.17 feet (all around)
5. Ridge Hipped Length = 32.67 feet
6. Ridge Height = 26 feet (assumed)
7. Eave Height = 18 feet (assumed)
8. Door Dimensions = 14 feet (H) x 14 feet (W)

The following wind load parameters were used to calculate the wind:

1. Ultimate Windspeed = 171 MPH (3-sec gust)
2. Risk Category = IV (essential facility – Fire Station)
3. Exposure = C
4. Building Enclosure = Enclosed

The wind pressures for components and cladding were calculated in accordance with ASCE 7-10 Allowable Strength Design (ASD). The following table summarizes the wind pressures.

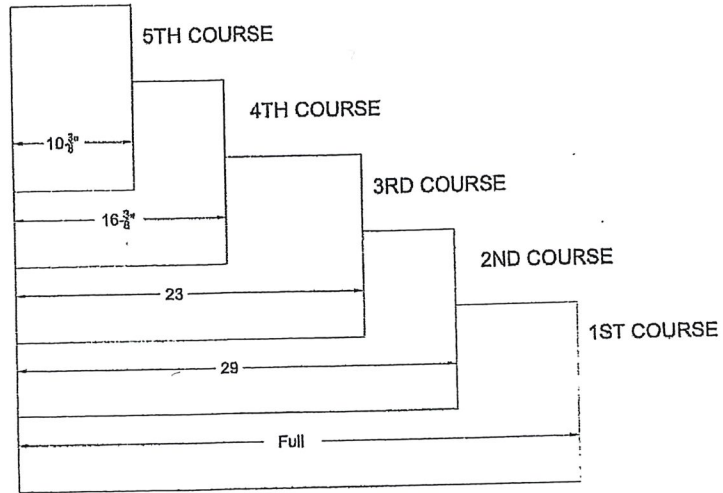

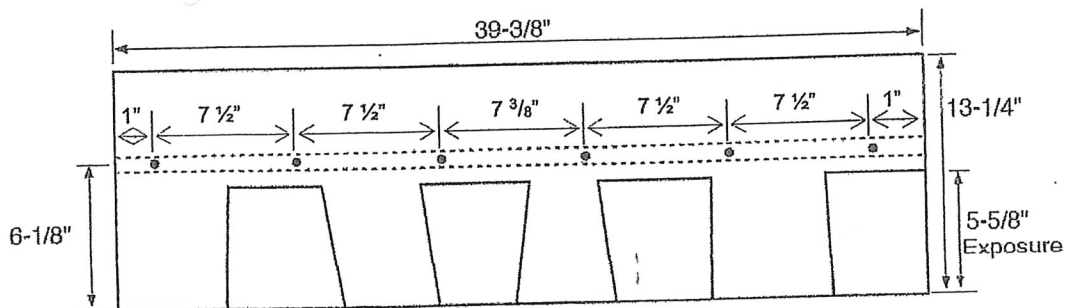
