Arbor Day and Great American Cleanup 2021 Saturday March 13, 2021

- Create centralized website to submit photos for possible prizes and City Managers report.
- Neighborhood groups - most interesting trash finds photo contest. Downtown Association and neighborhood volunteers can organize and identify their neighborhoods.

1715 Cannon Installation

- Matt will investigate the restoration of the cannons at Pinewood Park and the anchor near the garden club to see if a restoration can be done to the artifacts.

Electrical Box Artwork

- Charlene > New shortened process has been successful for the box artwork. All boxes first need to be approved by FPUA before art can be placed. Charlene attempts to find sponsors to cover the cost of the artwork and installation. Cost per a box is approximately large 1500, small square 800... depends on size box.
