## **Work Experience Summary:**

Over 40 years of professional library experience. I worked in academic, public, and special library positions with responsibilities covering the full spectrum of library service at various levels. The last 20 years were at the upper management levels.

April 1999- December 31, 2011 – Retired from the Library of Congress, U.S. Copyright Office, Chief, Copyright Acquisitions Division. For 12 years, I managed and supervised a small staff of 35 employees and supervisors in a strong federal union environment. My position required a strong knowledge of the union bargaining agreement and the Federal Personnel Regulations, especially as they related to merit promotion, performance measurement, individual development plans, and disciplinary or adverse actions. There were instances where I found it necessary to apply adverse actions for poor performance, leave abuse, or failure to report to work on time. I was a big advocate of providing appropriate training to staff. Additionally, I mentored and encourage staff in their individual upward mobility.

1990-1999 – U.S Department of the Army, Army Materiel Command, Command Librarian. Managed Command Library Programs for 35 libraries through out the United States. Libraries consisted of both post libraries (Public) and libraries supporting the very technical scientific research and development missions of their perspective organizations. Position required extensive understanding of the Federal Personnel Regulations to advise library supervisors under the command program. Position also required skills related to mentoring junior librarian, developing individual professional development plans for upward mobility and career counseling.

I believe the skills addressed above indicated I am professionally qualified to serve as a member of the Civil Service Board for the City of Fort Pierce.
