Facility or location proposed to be named:	Current small park area dedicated as "Law Enforcement Memorial Park" in May 1993, in SW corner of vacant property across from FPPD Main Station at 920 S. U. S. Hwy 1.
Brief summary of project:	The Charitable Trust has raised over \$50,000 so far to create a memorial for FPPD Sgt. Danny Parrish, who was killed in the line of duty 30 years ago and for whom no memorial has been established. A life sized statue of a fully uniformed Officer saluting the flag is currently being cast and will be placed in front of the Main Station in November. It is proposed to rename the small park recognizing Sgt. Parrish and expanding the name to encompass all first responders.
