

ORDINANCE NO. 21-032

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, **AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE II., DIVISION 1, SEC. 2-19 COMPENSATION** OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION DUE TO MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS AND CLARIFYING THE METHOD OF CHANGING COMPENSATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at a conference agenda meeting on July 12, 2021 and again on August 9, 2021, the Mayor and City Commission discussed the current salaries and the proper methods for changing said salaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Article II, Division 1, Section 2-19, of the Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-19. - Compensation.

- (a) Effective ~~October 1, 2019~~ April 1, 2021, the annual compensation of the mayor-commissioner of the city shall be ~~\$33,598.19~~ 36,301.20. Any modification to this amount must be done by ordinance specific to this section of the code.
- (b) Effective ~~October 1, 2019~~ April 1, 2021, the annual compensation of each city commissioner of the city shall be ~~\$25,757.00~~ 27,814.80. Any modification to this amount must be done by ordinance specific to this section of the code.
- (c) In no event shall the mayor-commissioner or city commissioners be compensated in excess of the salaries, provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section, for attending any regular, postponed or special meeting.
- (d) The compensation for the mayor-commissioner and city commissioners shall be payable at the same time that other city employees are paid.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof that may be determined to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is and the same shall become effective as of April 1, 2021.
