



The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, pursuant to the City Charter and Florida Statutes, will on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at their regular meeting which begins at 6:00 p.m. and on Monday, September 20, 2021, at their regular meeting which begins at 4:30 p.m., hold Public Hearings on the enactment of proposed ordinances on first and second readings respectively, in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 100 North U.S. Highway #1, Fort Pierce, Florida; said ordinances entitled:

ORDINANCE NO. 21-032 - AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE II., DIVISION 1, SEC. 2-19 COMPENSATION OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION DUE TO MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS AND CLARIFYING THE METHOD OF CHANGING COMPENSATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
