a. **Artwork at Sgt. Danny Parrish Fallen First Responders Park (In front of the FPPD)**

Bruce Murry requested consideration of the relocation of the current weathervane in the Sgt. Danny Parrish Fallen First Responders Park by the Arts and Culture Advisory Board. He showed the Board the sculpture/statue his organization is in the process of acquiring. This is a sculpture of a police officer with no identifying badge number or name plate. The Arts and Culture Board agreed with Mr. Murry about relocating the current art piece and placing the police statue. Each board member will present two locations as to where the current piece can be moved to in the City of Fort Pierce. They would like their recommendation to relocate the weathervane be sent to the City Commission to discuss at a future meeting.
