I'm Still Standing 2023 is a creative project that will partner survivors with professional artists to create artwork incorporating up-cycled/ recycled materials, allowing them to bravely share the truth about their experiences in a safe environment to actualize emotional strength, hope, health, and well being.

Each artist will receive a \$250 stipend, and each pair will receive \$250 in reimbursable expenses for material costs. Selected artists will need to attend an initial meeting to meet their survivors on August 11 at 6 PM at The Inner Truth Project. I'm Still Standing 2023 Artists will be announced at the Inaugural I'm Still Standing Exhibit Closing Night Reception on August 25 at the Cultural Alliance Gallery.
