

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to specialty license plates; amending
 3 s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of
 4 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop a
 5 Highwaymen license plate; providing for distribution
 6 and use of fees collected from the sale of the plates;
 7 providing a contingent effective date.

 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11 Section 1. Subsection (85) is added to section 320.08058,
 12 Florida Statutes, to read:

13 320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

14 (85) HIGHWAYMEN LICENSE PLATES.—

15 (a) The department shall develop a Highwaymen license
 16 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
 17 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
 18 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the word
 19 "Highwaymen" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

20 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the City
 21 of Fort Pierce, subject to a city resolution designating the
 22 city as the fiscal agent of the license plate. The city may use
 23 up to 10 percent of the fees for administrative costs and
 24 marketing of the plate and shall use the remainder of the fees
 25 as follows:

26 1. Before completion of construction of the Highwaymen
27 Museum and African-American Cultural Center, the city shall
28 distribute at least 15 percent to the St. Lucie Education
29 Foundation, Inc., to fund art education and art projects in
30 public schools within St. Lucie County. The remainder of the
31 fees shall be used by the city to fund the construction of the
32 Highwaymen Museum and African-American Cultural Center.

33 2. Upon completion of construction of the Highwaymen
34 Museum and African-American Cultural Center, the city shall
35 distribute at least 10 percent to the St. Lucie Education
36 Foundation, Inc., to fund art education and art projects in
37 public schools within St. Lucie County. The remainder of the
38 fees shall be used by the city to fund the day-to-day operations
39 of the Highwaymen Museum and African-American Cultural Center.

40 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2020, but
41 only if HB 387 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
42 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
43 extension thereof and becomes a law.
