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The City Commission-appointed Parking Committee has reviewed the below matters and has come to an agreement on recommending the topics for consideration. The committee recommends the following:

- no changes to the City Hall parking garage configuration.
  - The commission asked for feedback on 4 items regarding the garage and the committee tabled “Should there be designated visitor/employee parking? They do not support designated visitor parking.
- moving forward with the proposed temporary parking option at Atlantic Avenue & Melody Lane and consider installing lighting onsite.
- moving forward with the proposed Depot Drive (City-Owned Property) parking solution and consider installing lighting onsite and landscaping.
- moving forward with the proposed temporary parking solution along Indian River Drive
- tabling the paid parking portion of the proposed parking ordinance and allowing the remainder to move forward for approval.
- installing a parking counting system at the City’s garage that has the capability to provide daily reports on usage.
- installing a sign on Orange Avenue, Avenue A, and any other strategic locations directing jurors to park in the free City parking garage.
- installing signs in the parking garage that indicate there are cameras throughout the garage.
- not pursuing the use of the FEC Parking Lot (North of Orange Avenue) as a temporary parking solution
- recommends the City Manager coordinate a strategic meeting with the County Administrator, Clerk of Court, Court Administration, Public Defender, State Attorney, St. Lucie County Sheriff’s Office and representatives from St. Andrews Academy and the Law Library to discuss the five, ten, and 20-year-plan for the courthouse.
