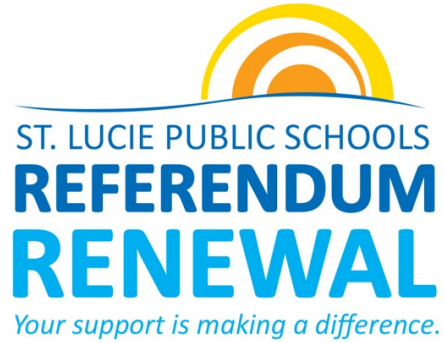
How Will Funds Be Spent?
