# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

## Our Current Reality

Traffic fatalities are a public health crisis affecting all road users.

**1.25M**

Lives lost globally each year from traffic crashes

# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

## SS4A Overview: Funding

### Funding

- \$1B annually, FY22-26
- At least 40% of annual funding will be awarded for Action Plan Grants and supplemental action plan activities
- Balance of funding available for Implementation Grants

### Cost share/match

- 80% Federal | 20% local match cost share
- Not more than 15% of funds can be awarded to projects in a single State in a given fiscal year
- *Note: Tribal projects are not considered part of the State cap*

### Recipient Types

- Single recipients
- Joint applications
  - Multijurisdictional groups could have varied structures to support local needs



# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

## SS4A Overview: Eligibility

### **Eligible Recipients**

- Metropolitan planning organization (MPOs)
- Political subdivision of a State
- Federally recognized Tribal government
- Multijurisdictional groups comprised of the entities above

### **Eligible Activities**

- Develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan
- Conduct planning, design, and development activities
- Carry out projects and strategies identified in an Action Plan



# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

## Action Plan Grant

Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP) – this document will identify and aid in prioritization of Low Cost Safety Improvements

# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

Implementation Grants – where the “rubber meets the road.”

## PROVEN SAFETY COUNTERMEASURES

- Speed Safety Cameras
- Appropriate Speed Limits
- Rumble Strips
- Enhanced Pavement Marking/Markers
- Traffic Signal Enhancements
- Access Management
- Crosswalk Visibility Enhancements
- Improved Lighting
- Sidewalk Improvements
- Road Safety Audits

Staff recommends applying for the Action Plan Grant

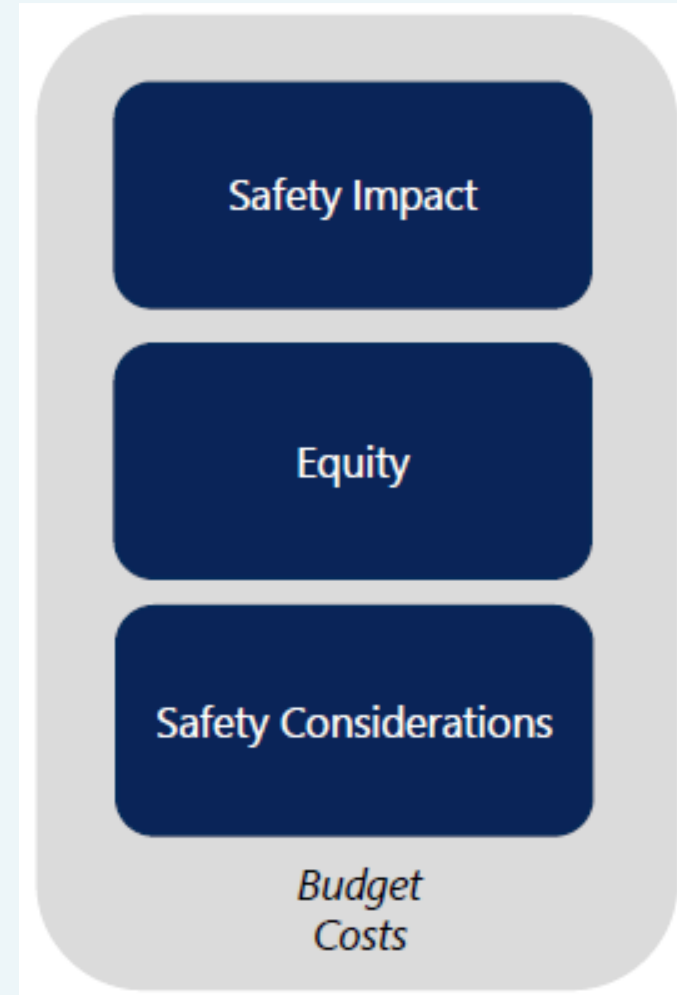
Applications are due September 15, 2022

Requesting \$300,000 (\$60,000 Local Match) for consultant to assist in developing the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan

# SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)

## Three Selection Criteria:

1. Safety Impact (quantitative, two ratings)
  - The count of roadway fatalities from 2016 to 2020
  - Fatality rate average from 2016-2020, divided by 2020 US Census population
2. Equity (quantitative, one rating)
  - Percent of population in underserved communities within the jurisdiction
3. Safety Considerations (narrative)
