Officer Daniel Thomas Parrish died in the line of duty on  
January 25, 1991, at the age of 27.

Officer Parrish was a dedicated and hardworking officer who served the Jacksonville Police Department for over 10 years. He was a member of the Jacksonville Police Association and the Jacksonville Police Officers' Guild. Officer Parrish was a family man and a devoted father. He was known for his integrity, honesty, and dedication to his job. He was a true hero and a role model for all of us.



Officer Parrish was presented with the rank of Sergeant following his death. In his honor, this memorial park was named the Sergeant Daniel Thomas Parrish Fallen First Responders Park.
