

**MASSEY HEARING**

**CONTESTING OF FINE/NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. THE GRAVITY OR SERIOUSNESS OF THE VIOLATION: Minimal.
  
2. ANY AND ALL ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE VIOLATOR TO CORRECT THE VIOLATIONS(S); OR IF THE VIOLATION(S) WERE NOT CORRECTED BY THE ORIGINAL VIOLATOR, WHAT ACTION WAS TAKEN BY ANY OTHER OWNER OR PARTY IN THE INTEREST TO BRING THE VIOLATION INTO COMPLIANCE? Owner obtained a permit for enclosing the loading dock but did not get the necessary inspections to close the permit and expired 9/27/2021. The permit was renewed on 2/18/2022.
