




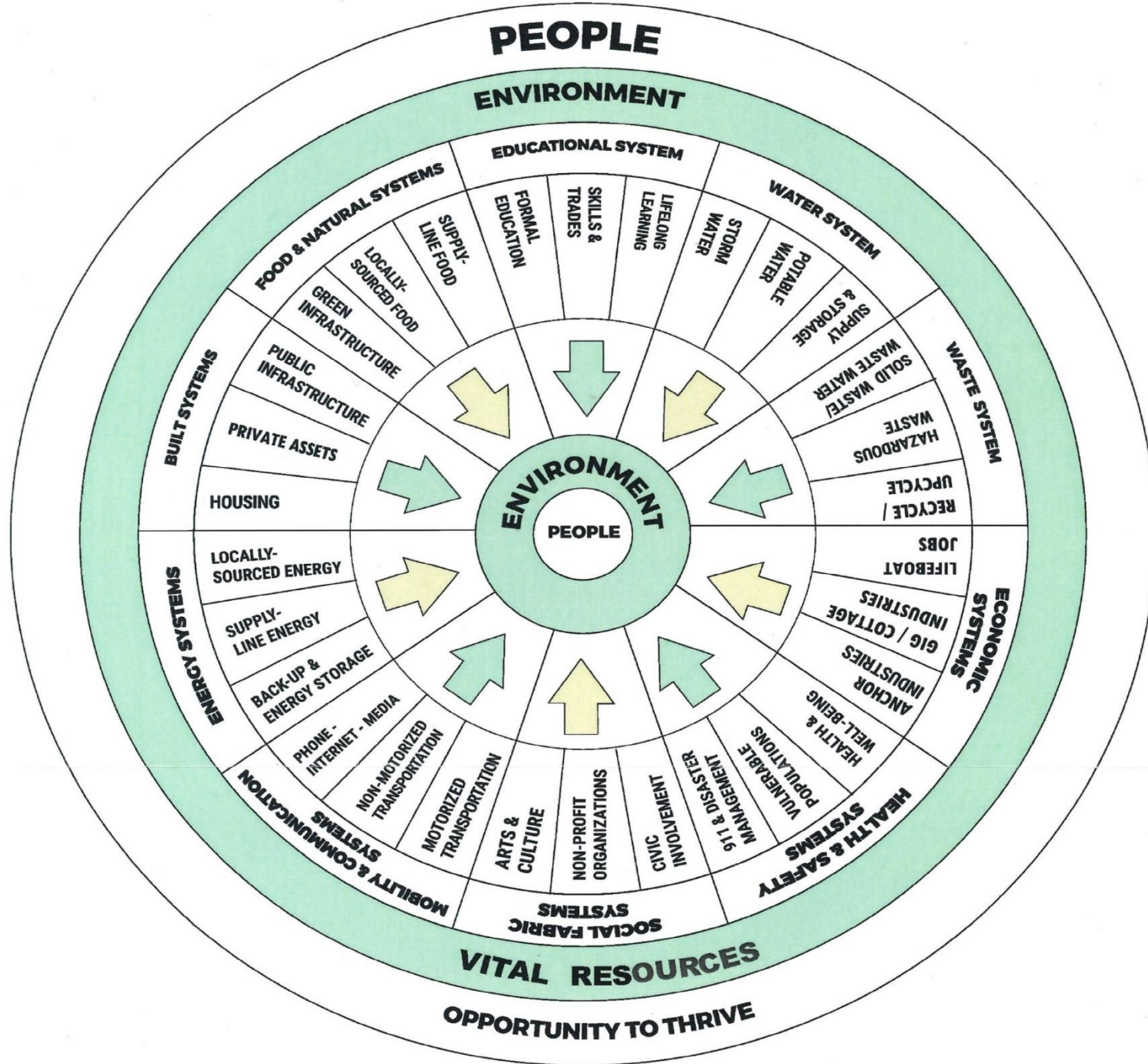

- ▶ **Create a Resilience Taskforce.**
 - ▶ **Identify vulnerabilities and make recommendations to the Commission for implementation of Capital Improvement projects and Ordinances.**
 - ▶ **Identify funding mechanisms for Capital Improvement projects and studies.**
 - ▶ **Establish partnerships with public and private sector entities to assure successful implementation of resilience objectives.**
