Lincoln Park SMART Neighborhood

- **Original plan**

- Location from Orange Avenue to Avenue D & 7th Street to 25th Street
- Fiber loop around the outside perimeter with only Wireless service inside

- **New plan**

- Location from Orange Avenue to Avenue D & 7th Street to 14th Street
- Fiber to every parcel (fiber-to-the-home & business)
- Free Public Wi-Fi in five key areas

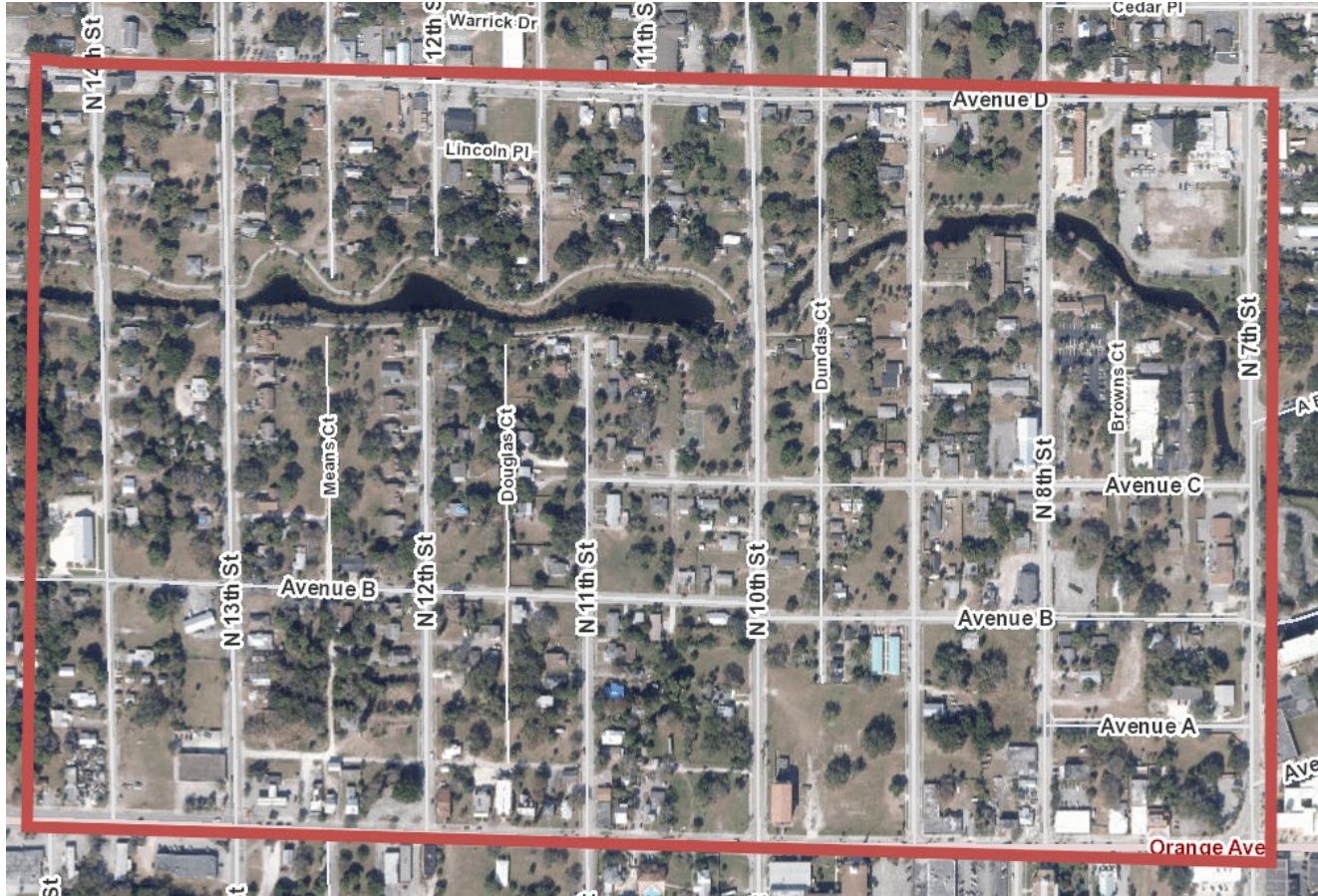

- **Detailed Engineering & Design**
 - Time Line: **Completed January 14th 2022**
- **ROW Permit Approval**
 - Time Line: **June 2022**
- **Underground Conduit Construction**
 - Time Line: **June 2022 – October 2022**
- **Fiber Materials Arrival**
 - Time Line: **October 2022 – December 2022**
- **Fiber Construction**
 - Time Line: **January 2023 – May 2023**

Infrastructure Bill

- \$65 Billion for Broadband & \$14.2B for a “sustainable” Affordability Connectivity Benefit
- \$30 per month voucher to use toward any internet service plan if a family meets at least one of the criteria
 - Has an income that is at or below 200% of the [federal poverty guidelines](#); or
 - Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or [Lifeline](#);
 - Participates in Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations;
 - Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision in the 2019-2020, 2020-2021, or 2021-2022 school year;
 - Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year; or
 - Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income program
