



The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, pursuant to Section 125-37 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Pierce, and Sections 166.041 (3)(a) and 163.3187 of Florida State Statutes, will on Monday, February 6th, 2023 at 5.05 p.m. and Tuesday, February 21st, 2023 at 5.05 p.m., hold Public Hearings on the enactment of the proposed ordinance on first and second readings, respectively, in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida, to consider review and approval of the following:

ORDINANCE 23-013 - AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE AMENDING THE CITY'S ZONING ATLAS AND ESTABLISHING A ZONING DESIGNATION OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT FOR FIVE (5) PARCELS CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 84.8 ACRES AND GENERALLY LOCATED AT OR NEAR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF N JENKINS ROAD AND FLOYD JOHNSON ROAD IN FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Subject Property: Comprises the following five (5) parcels, 2407-241-0001-000-3, 2407-231-0000-000-5, 2407-212-0001-000-3, 2407-221-0001-000-1 and 2407-211-0001-000-0, totaling approximately 84.8 acres.

All interested parties may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the ordinance. Said ordinance will be available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida.
