1. Provide a brief narrative as to how the Contractor/Grantee will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The City of Fort Pierce and FPUA will adhere to contract requirements, federal regulations and state laws and rules in meeting Civil Rights requirements. The City of Fort Pierce ("The City") and FPUA will follow Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 regulations by adopting required policies, ordinances and resolutions, designating various coordinators, advertising the coordinators' contact information, conducting various required activities, and establishing various complaint procedures and tracking logs.

The City and FPUA will take prompt actions to address any complaints it receives and will make every effort to resolve these complaints in a timely manner.

All complaints received, including verbal (phone calls, in person) and written, will be documented in appropriate log sheets for general citizen's complaints, Fair Housing complaints, EEO complaints and Section 504/ADA complaints. FPUA will notify its state/federal grant manager immediately upon receipt of any grant related complaints and will make efforts to address, assist, resolve and/or make referrals on complaints received, whether verbal or written. The actions, results and conclusions of these complaints will be recorded in the appropriate log sheets.
