Through our trauma informed and gender responsive services including an intensive academic program with wrap around counseling we assist girls to change their lives and futures for the better. After completing our program 100% of girls have improved academically and 91% no longer have any incidents with the Department of Juvenile Justice system.

Because of the Fort Pierce Police Departments continued support we are able to help girls find their voice, achieve their potential and celebrate a life defined by responsibility, dignity, serenity, and grace.
