Professional Background:

Mr. Wheler is the former owner, President and Chief Executive Officer of Allan Electric Company. The company was sold to UIL Holding Corp. (NYSE:UIL). Allan Electric Company was founded in 1948. The company was a major electrical contractor in New Jersey installing industrial, institutional, commercial, and highway electrical and teledata systems. The company employed 250-350 people and had sales between \$40-50 million annually. He resigned as President and CEO after a transition period.

For approximately ten years prior to joining Allan Electric, Mr. Wheler was President and before that Vice President of an electrical and mechanical contracting company. The company preformed projects throughout the eastern United States employing up to 450 people. The company's projects ranged in size from under \$100,000 to over \$12,000,000.

Mr. Wheler also worked as Regional Vice President for an environmental construction company managing five of the company's ten branch offices. He started his career as a consulting engineer working on wastewater treatment and water supply projects.

Since retiring Mr. Wheler has preformed several consulting assignments. He also founded the publishing company BookCollaborative.com.
