

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R48

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE **SOLID WASTE ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES AND APPROVING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND TRASH** IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 30-33 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-33, Fees – Current Schedule, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, states: “All fees due and payable to the city for services rendered is the collection and disposal of garbage and trash shall be in the amount established by resolution. The currently prevailing schedule of fees shall be available for public inspection at the office of the city clerk”; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2017, the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce adopted Resolution No. 17-R28 amending the Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2023, the City Commission discussed the need for an increase to the current fee schedule.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida:

SECTION 1. The City Commission does hereby adopt and ratify the **Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines** and the fees incorporated therein for collection and disposal of garbage and trash, as set out and attached in Exhibit “A”.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution but shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Resolution shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective October 01, 2023.
