a. Jaycee Park Playground Rebuild Update

Kaitlyn Ballard gave an update on the Jaycee Park playground project. It is coming along nicely, and hundreds of volunteers have assisted with this community build.

6. **New Business**

a. Quarterly Cleanup Saturday, November 19, 2022

Kaitlyn Ballard gave an update on the upcoming quarterly cleanup. These cleanups have been extremely successful and over a hundred volunteers have signed up for the on Saturday, November 19, 2022.

b. Great American Cleanup

The board discussed the upcoming Great American Cleanup and decided on Saturday, March 4, 2023, to host the event. This event will be an in-person event as it was in years past. KFPB will help select the projects for the event, volunteer at the event, etc.
