We have an opportunity to participate in the 2023 Youth Council Legislative Action Days Program, which will be held in Tallahassee, Tuesday – Wednesday, April 4-5, 2023 during the Legislative Session. If you are interested in attending, please review the email below discuss this with your parents and let me know what the decision is. The trip expenses will be covered by the City.

If we go, we would leave on Tuesday, April 3, and return Wednesday, April 5, 2023. Let me know as soon as possible.

The 2023 program will include a workshop on messaging and advocacy, an overview of the Legislative Session, a mock Legislative Session, and a visit to the Capitol building. There will be a separate training session for youth council coordinators on April 4. Participants must be members of an established municipal youth council to participate in this program.

### **Program Agenda:**

#### **Day One**

Youth council members will participate in a fun and engaging two-part workshop focused on youth engagement within their municipality. The first part will include issue identification, message development, and delivery, as well as role-playing and skill-building designed to improve participants' skills in public message delivery. The second session will focus on the dos and don'ts of advocacy with a tutorial on steps and protocols for effective advocacy in the public square. Participants will close with several mock and practice sessions to enhance and practice the skills they learned during the workshop. *Facilitator: Steve Vancore, President, VancoreJones*  
Youth council coordinators will have a separate training session on the first day of the program. *Facilitator: Michelle Bono, Bono Communications*
