Program Overview

The City of Fort Pierce Adopt-A-Road program provides opportunities for **individuals, businesses, clubs, and church** organizations to adopt a **half-mile** segment of a city-maintained roadway. Participants can help keep our city clean by simply agreeing to pick up litter and trash **a minimum of twelve (12) times a year**. Not only is this a great opportunity for a little exercise but organizations will also receive recognition in the form of a **sign** located on their adopted roadway.

Program Goals

- To Reduce litter along all City of Fort Pierce roadways.
- To keep the surrounding environment clean, including swales, canals, and stormwater inlets.
- To reduce litter overall by increasing public awareness.



Program Guidelines

1. Complete the online application.
2. Commit to completing a minimum of 12 cleanups per year. **(New)**
3. Adopt a 0.5-mile of the road.
4. Signs will be installed after application approval.
5. Volunteers can request for supplies like bags, picks and safety vests.
6. Safety Tips: Always wear furnished safety vests, Workers need to stay out of the traffic lanes and medians. Pick up trash in the right-of-way only, and, etc.
7. Participants are required to complete the online Litter Clean-Up Report Form. **(New)**
8. Trash removal can be requested through the Litter Clean-Up Report Form. **(New)**
9. If participants do not meet minimum requirements after one year, they will forfeit their adopted road for others to adopt. **(New)**

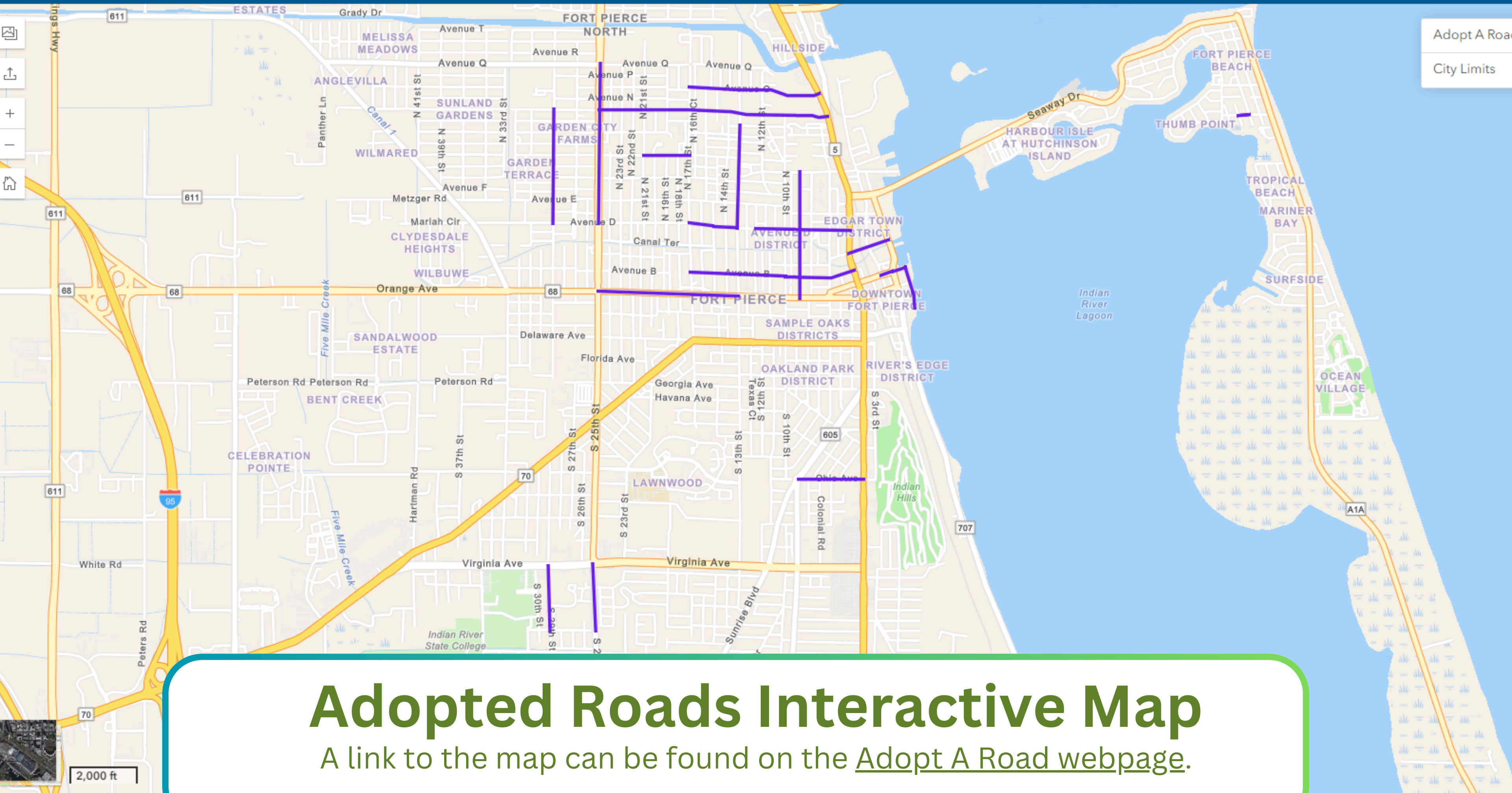
