

**CITY OF FORT PIERCE  
AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 125,  
ARTICLE 1, SECTION 125-3  
DEFINITIONS GENERALLY**

The City Commission will hold two PUBLIC HEARINGS on the proposed Ordinance, pursuant to Florida Statute 166.041 and City Code Section 125-37, on Monday, August 19, 2024 and Tuesday, September 3, 2024, at their meetings which begin at 5.05 p.m. in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida.

ORDINANCE 24-030 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA CHAPTER 125, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 125-3 DEFINITIONS GENERALLY TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS AND CLARIFY OTHER DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The proposed ordinance introduces additional definitions into the Planning section within Chapter 125 of the Code of Ordinances, which are needed to define terms not currently defined and to clarify others. In addition, the proposed amendment is also necessary in order to remove conflicts with State Statute and internal conflicts with the City's Code of Ordinances. The proposed amendment provides consistency with the City's Comprehensive Plan.

All interested parties may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. Said proposed ordinance will be available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida.

Pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, the City hereby advises you that if you or another person decide to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at its meeting or hearing, that you or said person will need a record of the proceedings, and that for such purpose, affected persons may need to insure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 286.26, Florida Statutes, persons with disabilities needing special accommodation to participate in this meeting should contact the City Clerk's Office at (772) 467-3065 at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
