Subject: Purchase of 12 Overt Community Security Cameras

The boundaries and the number of residents of our City continue to expand. Unfortunately, the staffing of the Fort Pierce Police Department does not mirror that growth. Our present call for service volume remains consistent at over 200 calls per day.

As we take steps to enhance our ability to ensure the quality of life for our citizens, we are respectfully requesting to purchase 12 overt (openly seen) cameras in key and highly visited areas of our City. This will allow us to monitor and address areas of concerns in a more efficient manner. The cameras will also bring a sense of comfort to our citizens in knowing the areas they are visiting are being monitored.

Ref: Request for Funding, Purchase of 12 Overt Community Security Cameras for Public Spaces

The Fort Pierce Police Department is committed to enhancing the safety and security of our community through innovative technology and strategic policing. In our continuous effort to leverage technology for better law enforcement and community service, we seek the City of Fort Pierce's support in funding the acquisition, through the Fort Pierce Redevelopment Agency, for the procurement of 12 overt community security cameras at strategic locations throughout the area. The total cost of this project is estimated at \$51,266.40.

Project Overview:

The primary goal of this project is to deter criminal activities, enhance public safety, and provide our law enforcement officers and staff with the tools they need to monitor community spaces more effectively. The proposed locations for the camera installations are as follows:

1. Lincoln Park Community Center - 1 Camera
 - a. 1306 Avenue M
2. Means Court - 1 Camera
 - a. 532 North 13th Street
3. Linear Park - 1 Camera
 - a. 400 block North 10th Street
4. SLC Transit - 1 Camera
 - a. 725 Avenue D
5. Manatee Center - 2 Cameras
 - a. 480 North Indian River Drive
6. Marina Square - 2 Cameras
 - a. 1 Avenue A
7. Jaycee Park - 2 Cameras
 - a. South Ocean Drive and Melaleuca Drive
8. Jetty Park - 2 Cameras
 - a. Seaway Drive and South A1A

Technical Specifications and Operational Framework:

The selected cameras are of high quality and are designed to operate over a WiFi connection in partnership with the Fort Pierce Utility Authority. This ensures a reliable and cost-effective solution for the project. The cameras will be integrated into the pending Flock OS platform, enabling real-time monitoring by officers and staff. This capability is crucial for prompt response to incidents and for the overall safety of our community members and visitors.

Benefits to the Community:

- **Deterrence of Criminal Activities:** The presence of security cameras serves as a strong deterrent to potential criminals.
- **Enhanced Public Safety:** The project will contribute to the safety and well-being of residents, visitors, and businesses in the area.

- **Community Confidence:** Improves the community's perception of safety, encouraging more vibrant and active use of public spaces.

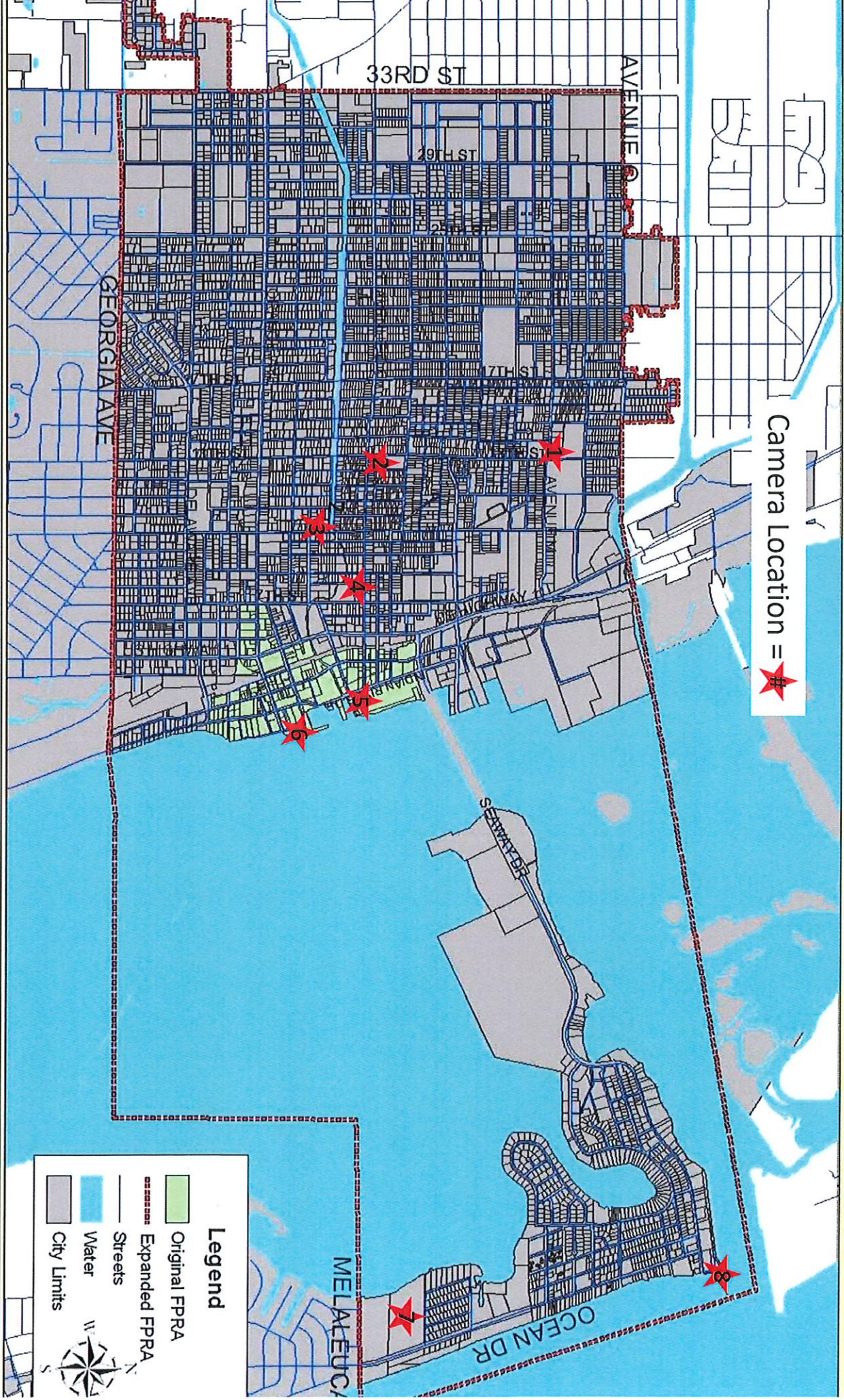
