WHEREAS, Vietnam veterans contribute to our city, county, state and nation by offering skills, education, leadership, and dedication learned in military service; and

WHEREAS, the city of Fort Pierce is home to many Vietnam veterans; and

WHEREAS, we can never fully repay our debt of gratitude to those brave men and women who served, were wounded, or died in battle; and

WHEREAS, Vietnam Veterans Day presents the opportunity for the people of Fort Pierce to honor and thank our Vietnam veterans for their service to our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Linda Hudson, Mayor of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, do hereby proclaim March 29, 2025 as:
