The program offers our youths a personal awareness of the criminal justice system through training, practical experiences, competition and other activities. Additionally, the program promotes personal growth through character development, respect for the rule of law, physical fitness, and good citizenship.


Mustard Seed Ministries - \$10,000

The Mustard Seed Ministries' mission through their Sarah's Kitchen hot meal program, and social services aimed at preventing homelessness aims to address the immediate needs of families so that they can stabilize and begin resolving the root causes of their crisis. Mustard Seed Ministries is a partner with the Fort Pierce Police Department and supports our Courageous Kids Program providing meals to our youth on Tuesday evenings.

Northside Bat and Ball Little League Baseball - \$5,000

The Northside Bat and Ball Little League Baseball, Inc. is a nonprofit organization focused on youth baseball designed for children and teenagers. It focuses on teaching the fundamentals of baseball, promoting teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play, in a recreational setting.
