PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the 18th Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup will be held on July 26, 2025, thanks to the hard work and dedication of the Marine Industry Association of the Treasure Coast, Inc. in conjunction with the Florida Navigation District, sponsors, and thousands of volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the City cannot honor the commitment without continuing to fight for better water quality within our local waterways.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Linda Hudson, Mayor of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, do hereby proclaim the week of July 19-27, 2025 as:
