

RESOLUTION NO. 25-R57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, SETTING A DATE FOR A **SPECIAL ELECTION** FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING THE VACANCY OF CITY COMMISSIONER, DISTRICT 2, SEAT 2; ESTABLISHING A QUALIFYING PERIOD; SETTING THE DATE FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION IF NECESSARY AFTER THE SPECIAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Commissioner James A. Taylor, Jr. resigned from office effective August 2, 2025, thus creating a vacancy for District 2, Seat 2; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 28, of the City Charter states: "At the time the vacancy occurs, if there is more than six (6) months before the next general election, a special election shall be set as early as legally possible and no temporary appointment shall take place"; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 52(h), of the City Charter states: "Special municipal elections for any purpose shall be held in the same manner as a regular election except the city commission, by resolution or by ordinance, shall fix the date of holding such special election, the office to be balloted upon and a qualifying period for candidates, or the question to be balloted upon"; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 52(c) of the City Charter states: "When there are only two (2) candidates for any one office in a regular municipal election, the names of both candidates shall be placed on the general election ballot; and the candidate receiving a majority of the total votes cast for such office shall be declared elected to such office"; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 52(d) of the City Charter states: "When three (3) or more persons qualify as candidates for any of the designated seats of the city commission or mayor to be filled, the persons' names who so qualified shall appear on the ballot and be voted upon at a primary election to be held on the day established by F.S. § 100.061 prior to the general election. Each candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast at the primary election for a designated seat shall be declared elected without the necessity of being voted upon in the regular city election. In the event no single candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in the primary election for a designated seat, the two (2) persons receiving the highest number of votes cast for that designated seat on the city commission or mayor shall be voted upon at the regular city election conducted on the date of the general election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered years"; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission determines it is of vital importance to the citizens of Fort Pierce to have full representation on the City Commission in a timely and expeditious

manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, pursuant to Article III, Section 28 and Article VI, Section 52(h) of the City Charter, hereby sets the date for a Special Election to be held on November 4, 2025, for the purpose of filling the vacancy of City Commissioner, District 2, Seat 2.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, pursuant to Article VI, Section 52(h) of the City Charter, hereby establishes the qualifying period for the Special Election to begin at noon on August 18, 2025 and end at noon on August 22, 2025.

SECTION 3. The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, pursuant to Article VI, Section 52(d) of the City Charter, hereby sets the date for a Run-Off Election to be held on January 13, 2026, for the purpose of filling the vacancy of City Commissioner, District 2, Seat 2, in the event a Run-Off Election is necessary.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
