I have reviewed the request for legal services related to the artist agreement and artist limited release for the Highwaymen Museum mural. A redlined copy of the artist agreement is attached with the following substantive changes:

- Risk Management's recommended language under the Indemnification section was added.
- Your submission asked whether the agreement should include the responsibility of the City to arrange the closure/blockage of the street to allow the Artist to access a lift. If there is an understanding between the artist and the City/FPRA on the City's/FPRA's responsibility to procure the closure, then a provision should be included in the agreement memorializing this understanding. I added section 4 under "Special Provisions" to generally describe what is requested, but please review this for any edits you believe are appropriate. It is advised that you speak with the Police Department on the feasibility of closing down the street and what that may involve the Police Department (in manpower or other resources).
 - Section 4 reads: "It is anticipated that during the course of ARTIST's work, the ARTIST will utilize equipment, such as a lift, to reach the areas of the building's wall that are inaccessible without assistance. It is anticipated by the ARTIST that said equipment will need to be situated on a public street, necessitating closure or blockage of the street. The CITY and/or FPRA shall make all reasonable arrangements to assist closure or blockage of the street for the ARTIST, to include employing the assistance of the police department."

The artist limited release and clean copy of the artist agreement are approved as to form and correctness.
