## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE EMERGENCY VEHICLE PREEMPTION SYSTEM

### 1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) outlines the roles and responsibilities between the City of Fort Pierce's Grants Administration Division and the Engineering Department for the implementation of the Emergency Vehicle Preemption System Initiative utilizing CDBG funds.

### 2. Scope of Work

The project involves procurement and installation of 46 Glance TIMM 500 Preemption Systems at designated intersections within the city. Each unit integrates preemption and priority technology using AI-driven, video-capable controllers to enhance emergency response capabilities.

A detailed scope is included as Attachment A.

### 3. Budget

The estimated budget for the project includes two potential configurations as outlined below. A final configuration will be selected based on funding and operational needs: A full breakdown is included in Attachment B.

- 10-Year Data Plan: 46 units \$6,456.00 each = \$296,976.00
- 5-Year Data Plan: 46 units \$5,414.00 each = \$249,044.00
- Budget line references: Line Item 934, 663-01-011-a, Page 70/121 and Page 57/121.

### 4. Responsibilities

#### 1. Grants Administration Division:

- Oversight of CDBG compliance
- Coordination with HUD reporting and legal review
- Disbursement of funds upon invoice approval

#### 2. Engineering Department:

- Project scoping, procurement, and vendor coordination
- Technical review and site installation oversight
- System testing and closeout coordination



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## **5. Reporting & Documentation**

Monthly project status updates, progress documentation, and a final project closeout report shall be submitted to the Grants Administration Division.

## **6. Term**

This MOU shall be effective upon signature and remain in effect through project completion and closeout certification.

## **Emergency Vehicle Preemption System**

Project Location: Various Intersections in Fort Pierce, Florida

### **Scope of Work**

**Project Overview:** This project involves the procurement and installation of 46 Glance TIMM 500 Preemption Systems at designated intersections within the City. Each unit integrates preemption and priority technology using AI-driven, video-capable controllers to enhance emergency response capabilities. The units will be installed by the City's Engineering Department Traffic Division Staff.

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#### **PHASE 1: Procurement**

##### **1.1 Purchase**

- Purchase the forty-six (46) Glance TIMM Preemption units from the supplier.
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#### **PHASE 2: Installation and Testing**

##### **2.1 Installation**

- Install and integrate the units into the existing traffic controller units, which are to be installed by the Engineering Department Traffic Division Staff.
  - 46 intersections in Fort Pierce (See attached map for locations)

##### **2.2 Field Testing**

- Once the units have been installed, staff will begin testing the units to ensure seamless operation once the system goes live.

##### **2.3 Project Updates**

- Provide updates and documentation to the appropriate divisions for compliance with grant requirements.
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#### **PHASE 3: Coordination and Project Closeout**

##### **3.1 Coordination**

- Inform the various agencies of the completed installation so that they may begin utilizing the equipment.
