

RESOLUTION NO. 25-RXX

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA; **ADOPTING UPDATED SOLID WASTE ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES AND APPROVING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND TRASH; CODE OF ORDINANCES, FAMILY DWELLINGS, CHANGAND CORRECTING FEE RATES** ;, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 30-33 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-33 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida states that “[a]ll fees due and payable to the city for services rendered in the collection and disposal of garbage and trash and for the availability of service for the collection and disposal of garbage and trash shall be in the amount established by resolution”; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2017, the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce adopted Resolution No. 17-R28 amending the Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2023, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 23-R48, reassessing and amending the Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines. However, calculation errors were subsequently discovered necessitating revisions; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2023, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 23-R51 with the amended Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2025, the Public Works Department addressed the need for adjustments to the fee schedule to better address the current demands for solid waste collection services with the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2025, the City Commission approved Resolution 25-R62. However, scrivener's errors were subsequently discovered necessitating revisions; and

WHEREAS, the administrative guidelines to track the language in the Code of Ordinances, e bulk yard waste collection for multiple family dwellings, e the date of residential refuse container pickups to Thursdays, and correct the fee rates charged for mechanical dumpsters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida:

SECTION 1. The City Commission does hereby adopt and ratify the **Solid Waste Administrative Guidelines** and the fees incorporated therein for collection and disposal of garbage and trash, as set out and attached in Exhibit “A”.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution but shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Resolution shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
