Overview

The Youth Banner Art Showcase was created to engage local students (grades K–12) in celebrating community pride through art. This year, a total of 80 creative and inspiring submissions were received from students across local schools. Each artwork reflects the community’s vibrancy, diversity, and spirit.

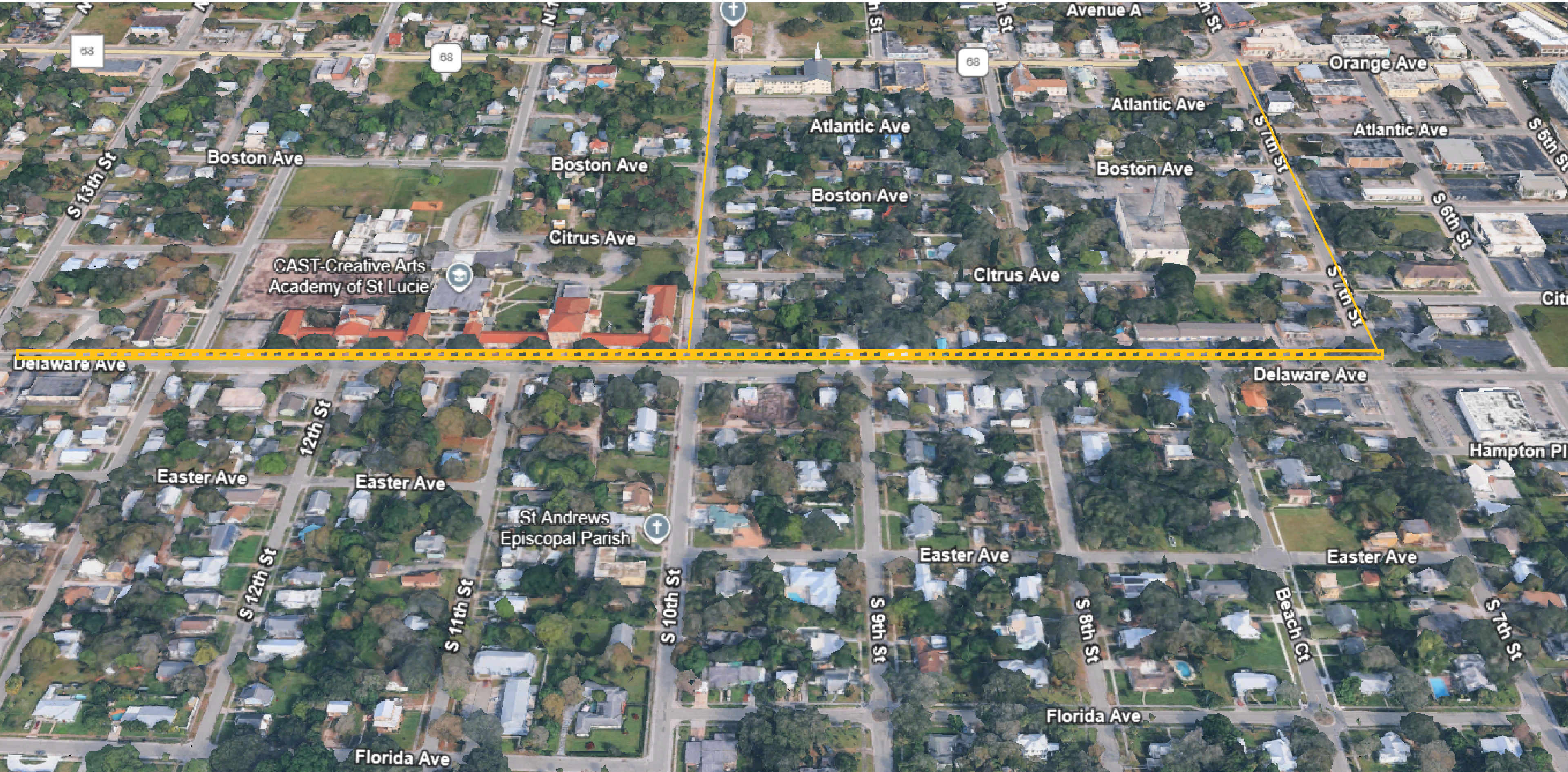
Banner designs were required to align with one of the approved themes and be the students original work:

- **Fort Pierce Landmarks**
- **Arts & Culture**
- **Nature/Scenic**

The CRA Advisory Committee (CRAAC) reviewed each submission, evaluating them on alignment with the theme, visual impact and readability, artistic skill, and overall execution.

After careful review, the CRA Advisory Committee recommended that the FPRA Board approve all eligible artworks to be reproduced on banners and displayed on streetlight poles throughout the Peacock Arts District, promoting youth creativity and community pride.

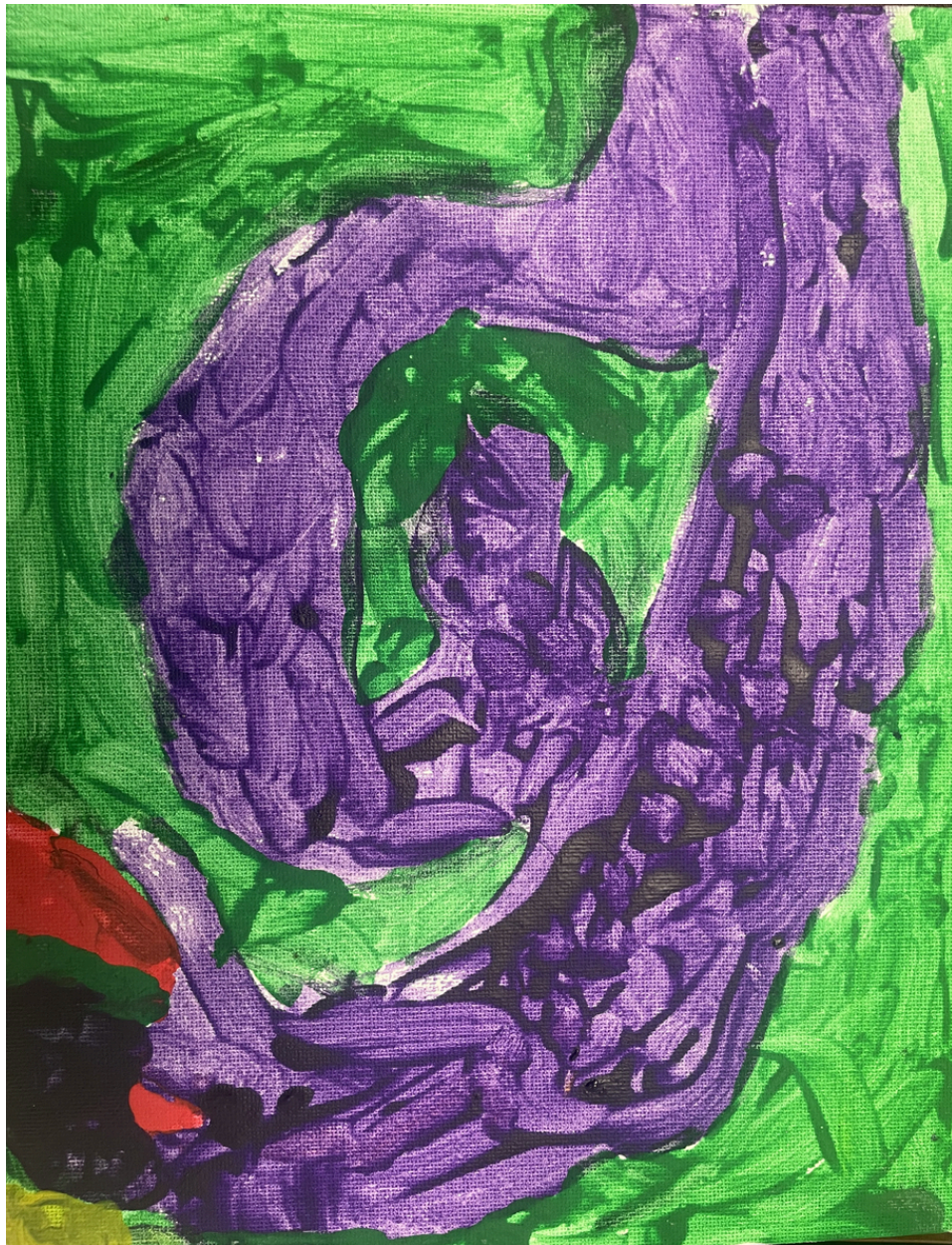

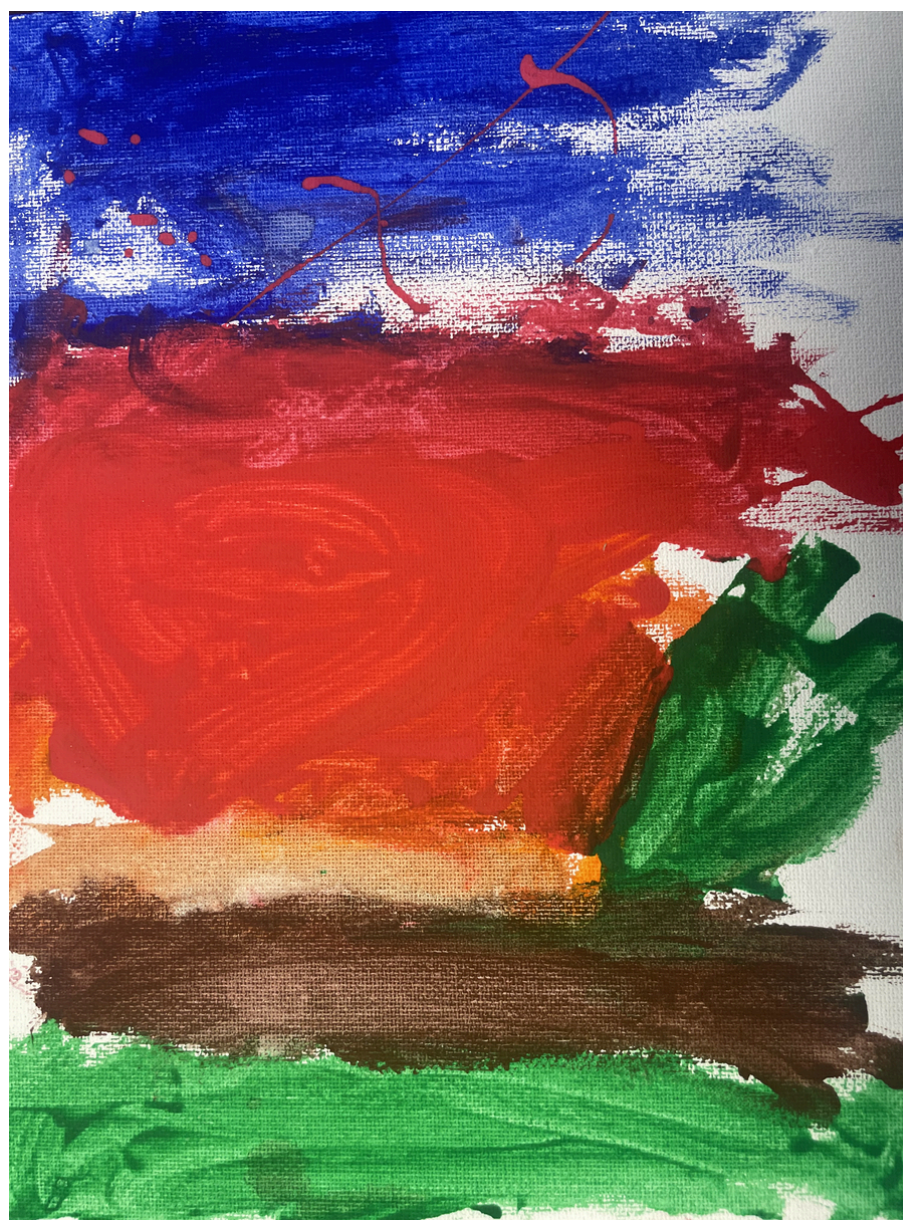

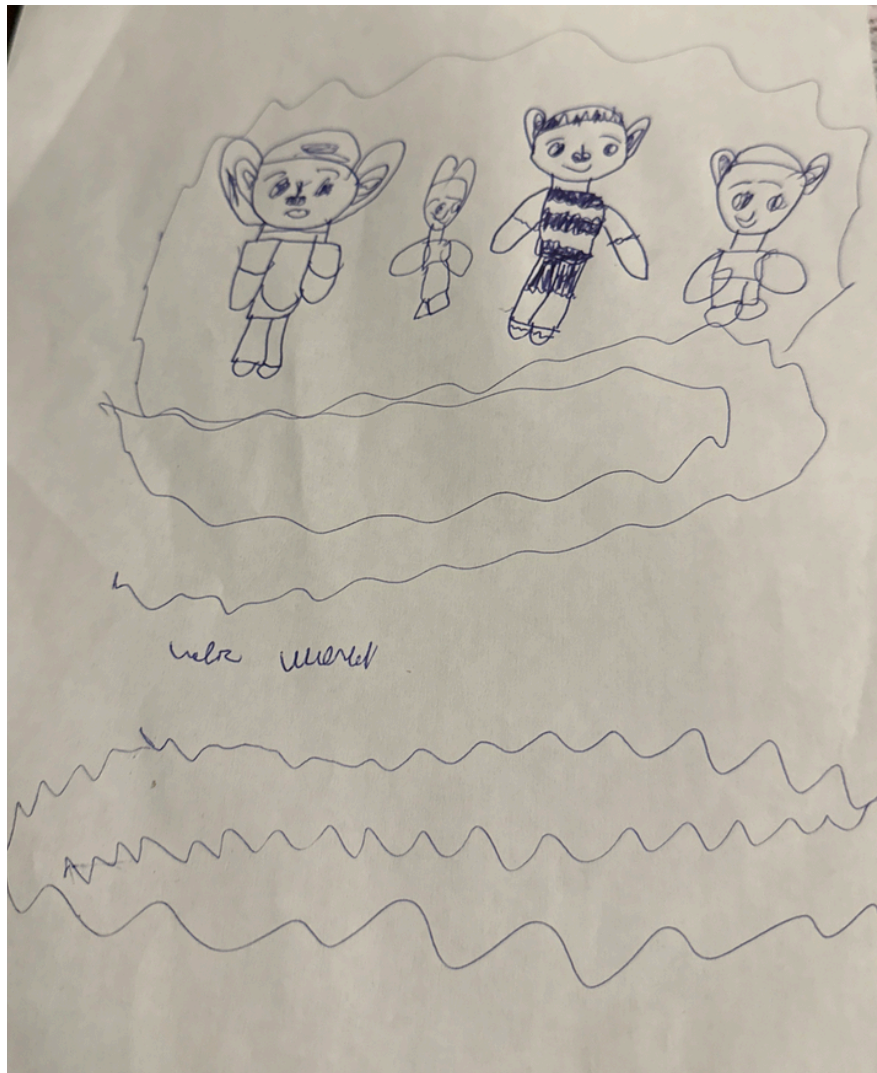

I tried to do it because I tried to do a character, but I didn't really know how to do it so I tried to do it like that there's four of them and yeah



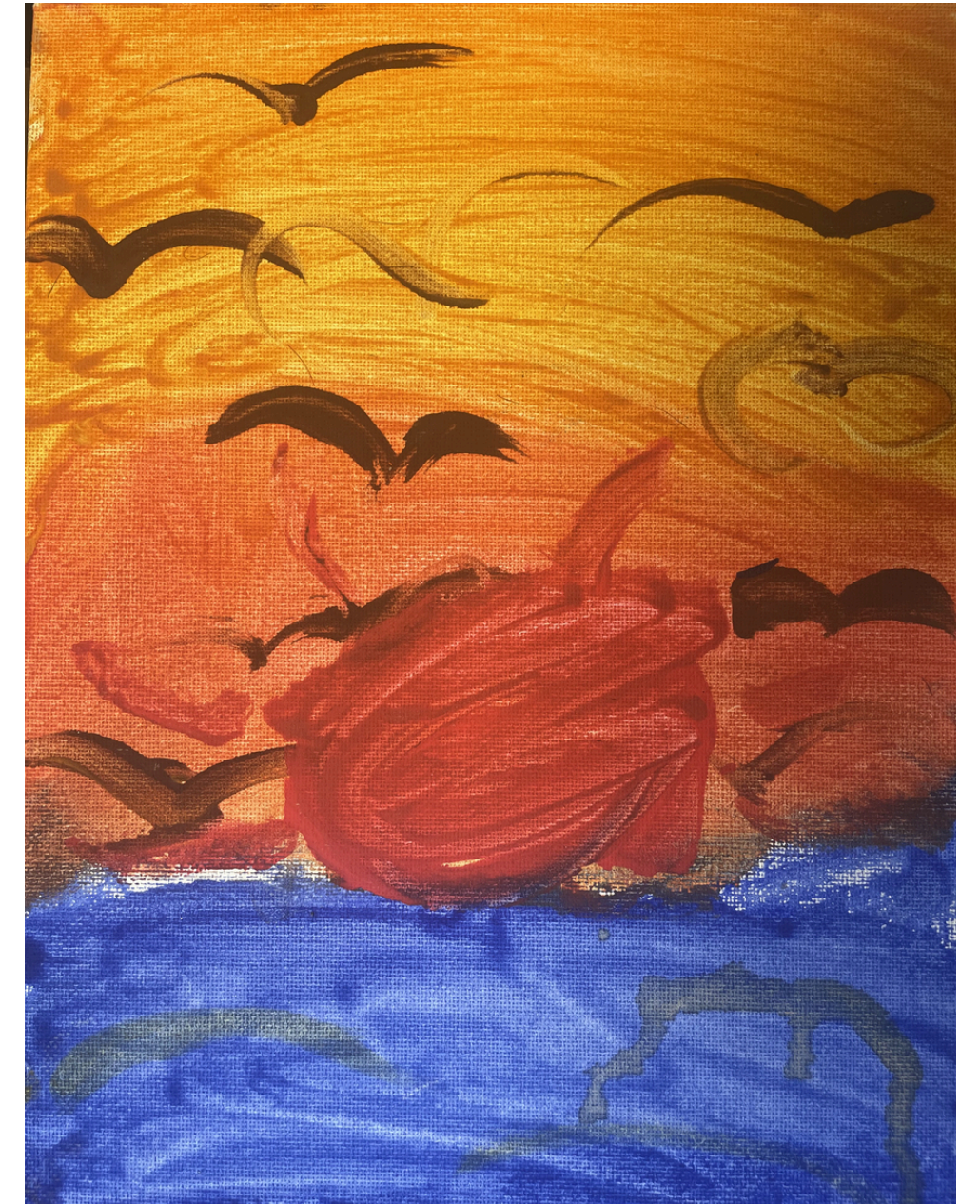

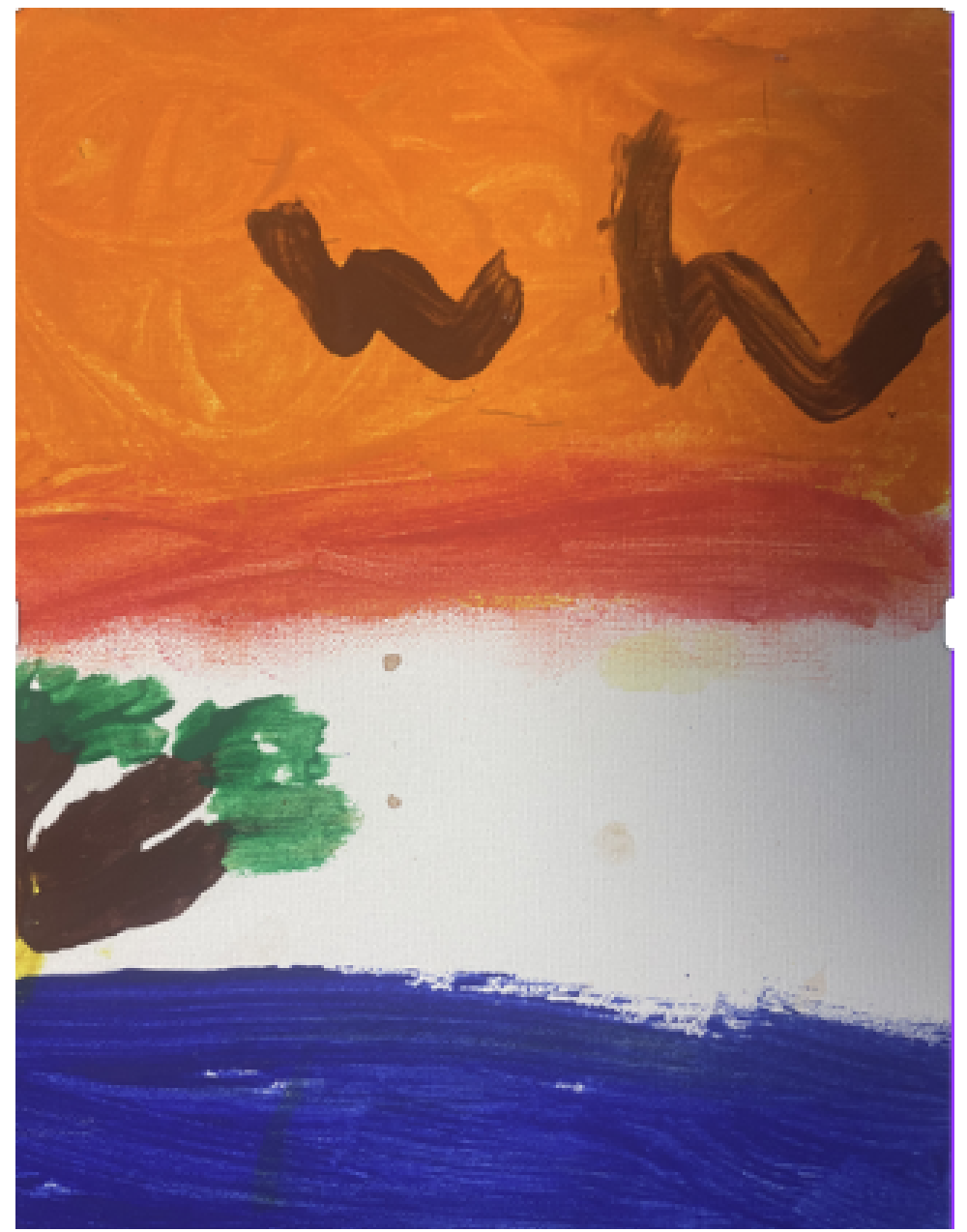

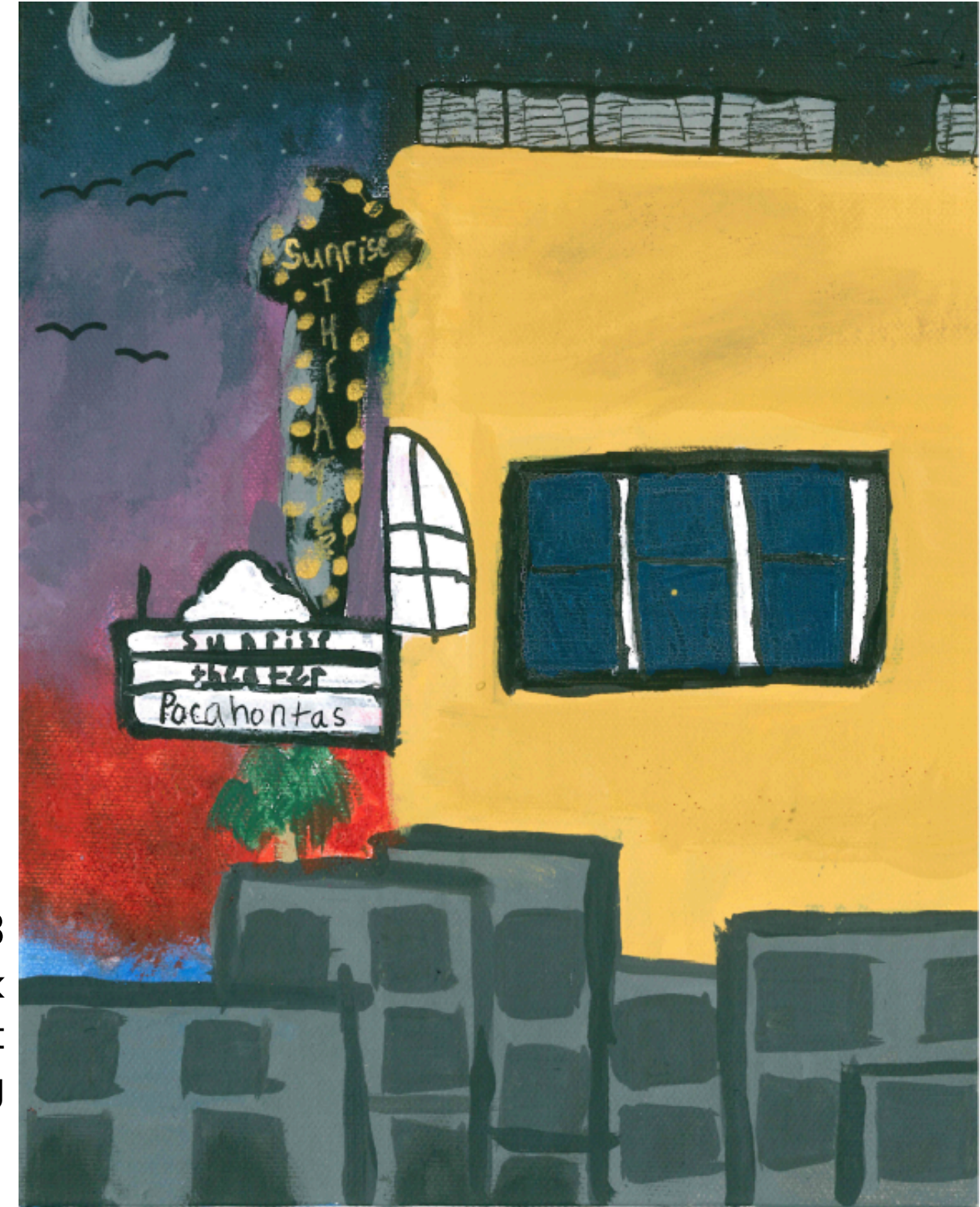

My design includes nature and scenic features because I wanted to do Florida butterflies in the sunset.



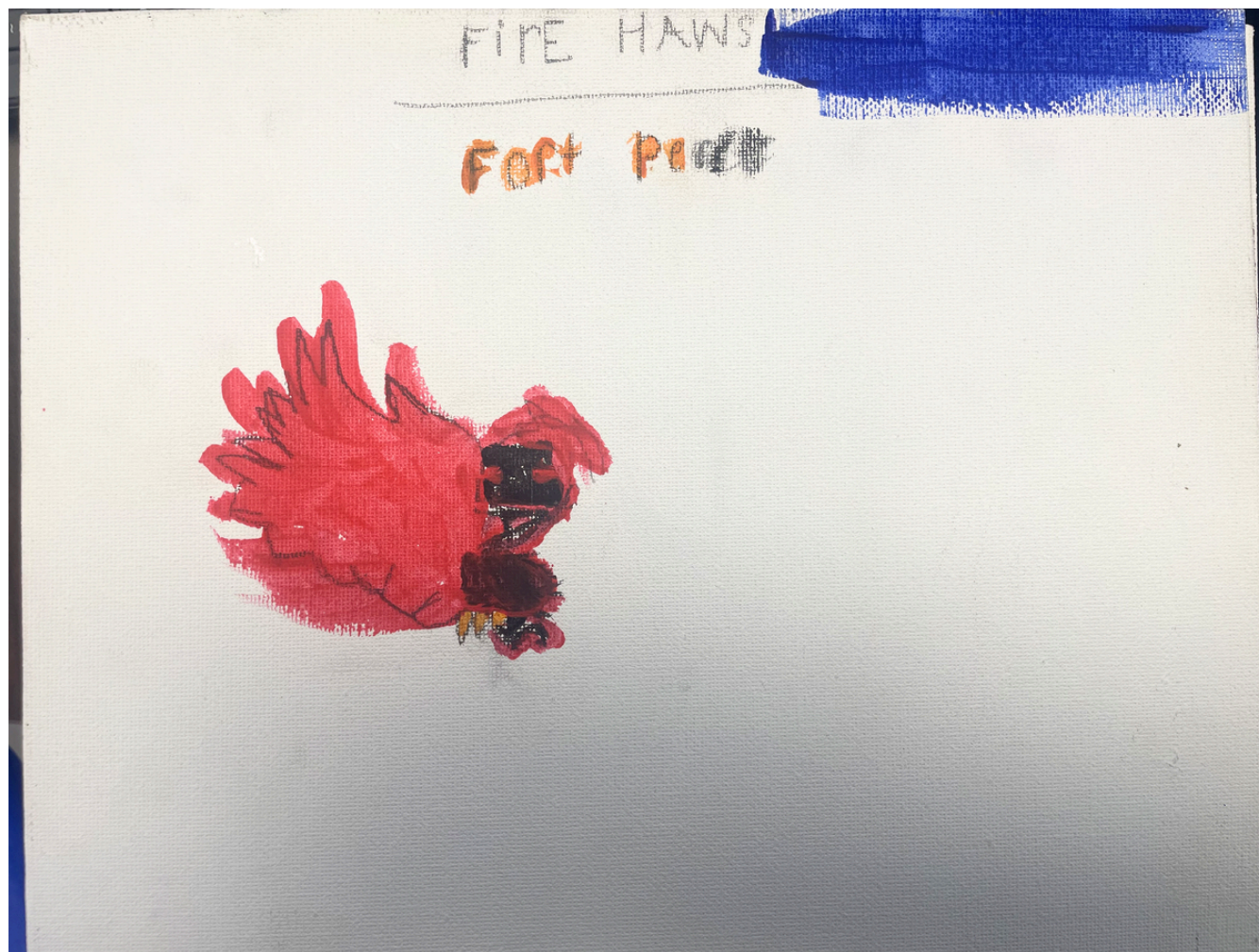

My design is an image of a peacock. It relates to the theme of scenic and nature because we see peacocks often on our school campus.

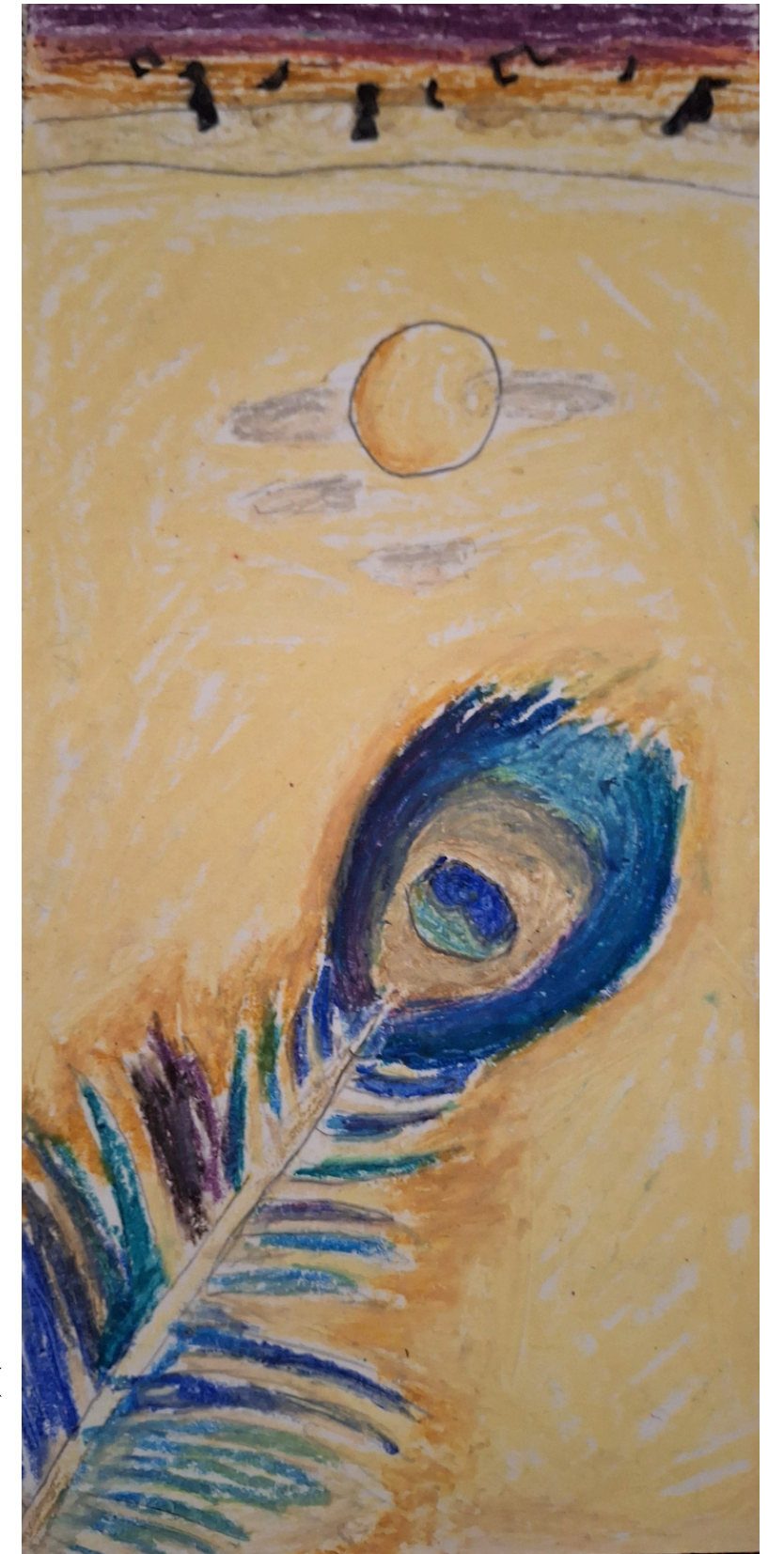

The house is one of the oldest houses in Fort Pierce. It was owned by Zora who is a black person who helped with making the Crayola crayon.

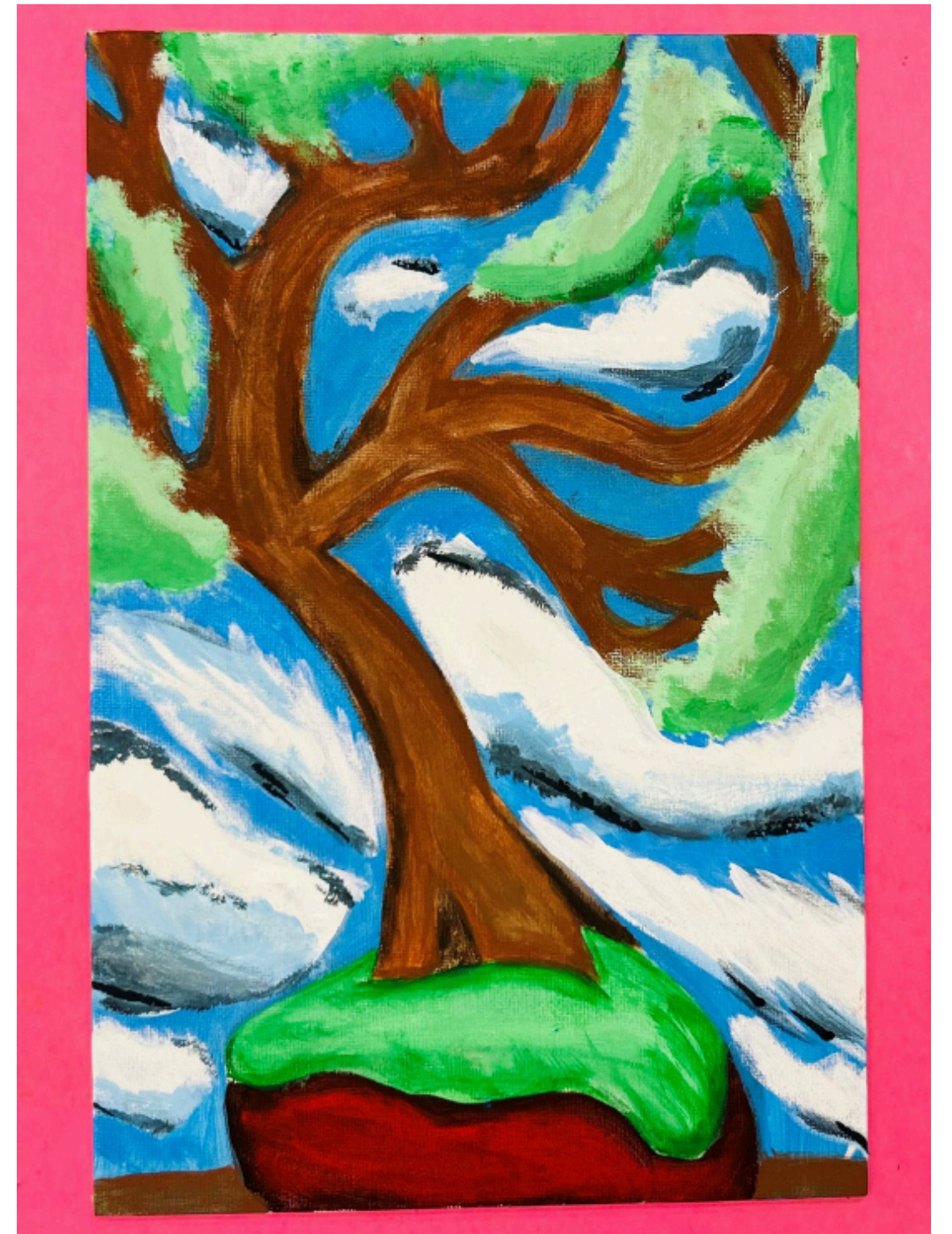

The artwork relates to Florida and Ft. Pierce from the local Tropicana plant and citrus groves in Ft. Pierce.



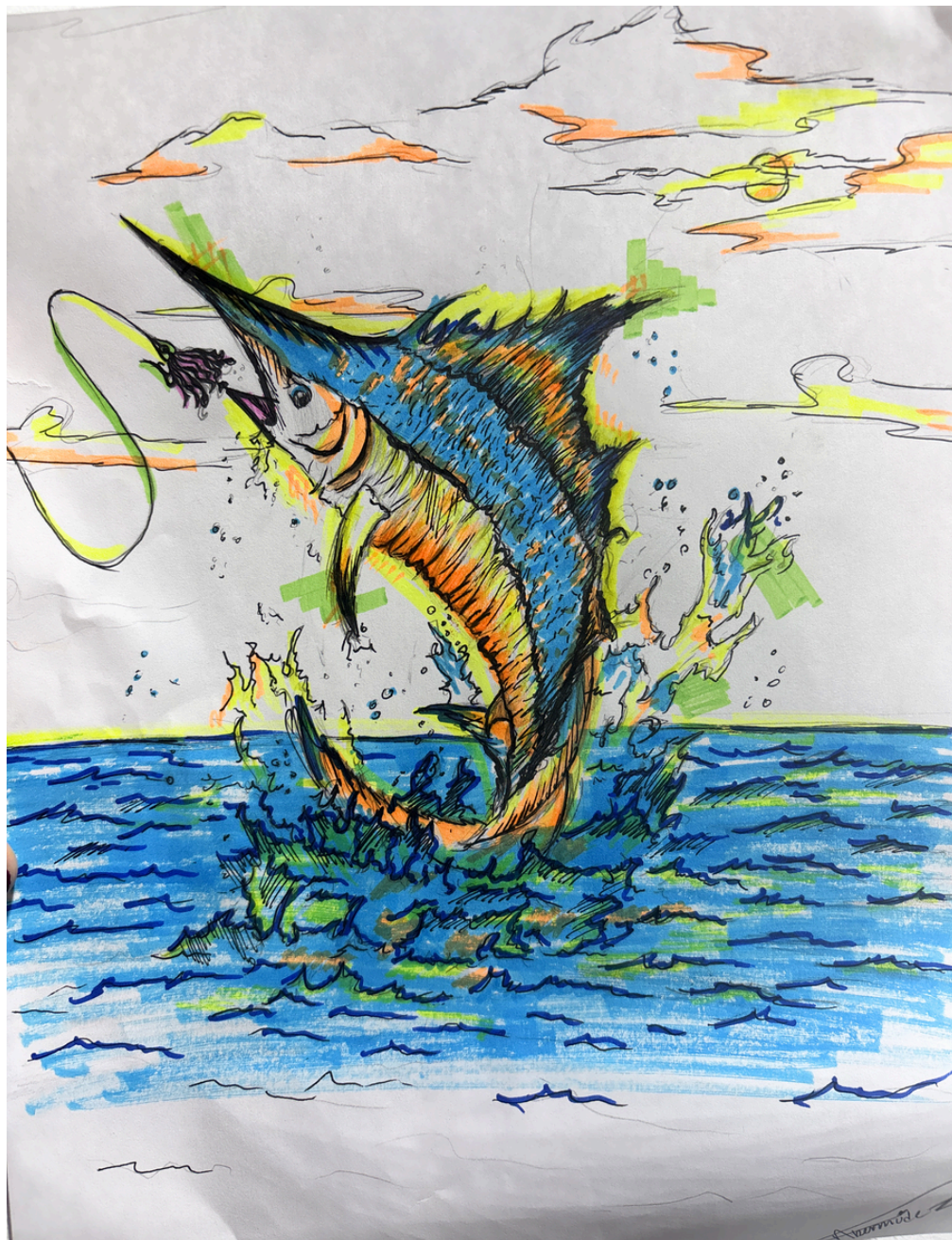
