# Aim of the project

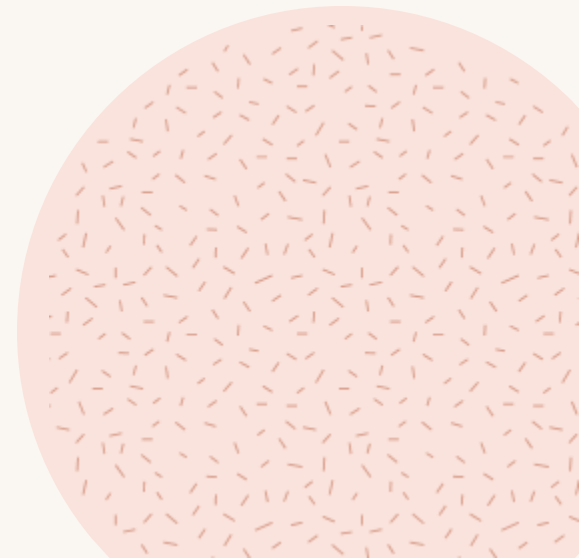
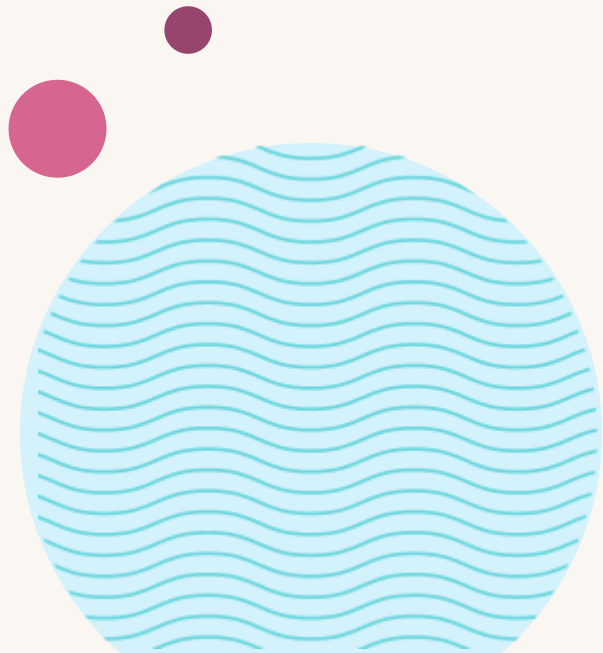
1. To help those in fort pierce who need it
