

RESOLUTION NO. 25-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, **APPROVING THE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICE PISTOLS FOR THE FORT PIERCE POLICE DEPARTMENT; DECLARING CERTAIN POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICE FIREARMS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR TRADE-IN PURSUANT TO BID NO. 2024-025 – SERVICE PISTOL PURCHASE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City issued Bid No. 2024-025 to allow the City of Fort Pierce Police Department to transition its currently issued service firearms and related equipment to updated models and accessories; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bid No. 2024-025, the City solicited qualified firms to facilitate the transition of the Fort Pierce Police Department's current firearms to updated models and supporting accessories; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2024, Lawmen's & Shooter's Supply, Inc. (the "Contractor") submitted a bid in response to Bid No. 2024-025; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2025, the City Commission authorized the award of Bid No. 2024-025 to the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Purchase Agreement for Service Pistols for the Fort Pierce Police Department ("Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, contains the negotiated terms between the City and the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement formalizes the understanding between the City and the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Pierce Police Department received firearms and related accessories contemplated in the Agreement in May and July of 2025 from the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Pierce Police Department still seeks to receive firearm accessories, as contemplated in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City issued payments in the amount of \$167,964.30 for the firearms and related accessories, as contemplated in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Agreement, the City is given a trade-in credit from the Contractor for certain City-owned service firearms as a trade-in credit toward the purchase of new firearms and accessories; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission must declare such service firearms as surplus property in order to lawfully dispose of them and apply their value as a trade-in credit; and

WHEREAS, the specific service firearms to be declared surplus are identified in the Fixed Asset Control Form attached hereto as Exhibit "B", which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that declaring the Police Department's currently issued service firearms as surplus and authorizing their trade-in toward the purchase of replacement firearms will reduce the City's overall costs by approximately **\$61,454.00**, resulting in significant savings on the acquisition of new firearms, and, is in the City's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida:

SECTION 1. The foregoing finds are incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce approves and authorizes the Purchase Agreement for Service Pistols for the Fort Pierce Police Department in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. The service firearms identified in the Fixed Asset Control Form in Exhibit “B” are hereby declared surplus property of the City of Fort Pierce.

SECTION 4. The City Commission authorizes the trade-in of said service firearms to Lawmen’s & Shooter’s Supply, Inc., in accordance with the terms of the Purchase Agreement for Service Pistols for the Fort Pierce Police Department.

SECTION 5. That the Mayor and the City Manager, City Attorney, and City Clerk, or their designees, are hereby authorized to take all necessary actions to carry out the intent of this Resolution, including execution of related documents.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
