TAB – B: ORGANIZATION PROFILE AND QUALIFICATIONS

Cross Environmental Services, Inc. (“CES”) is a specialty environmental contractor with over 37 years of experience providing demolition and abatement services for municipalities, state agencies, and private entities across Florida and 11 other states. CES was founded on February 10, 1988, in Florida. Our corporate office is located at 39646 Fig Avenue, Zephyrhills, FL 33540. We have two satellite offices, one in Pompano Beach, FL and the other in Fort Walton Beach, FL.

Since its founding in 1988, CES has grown into one of Florida’s largest asbestos abatement and demolition firms, with a proven track record of delivering safe, efficient, and compliant services on an as-needed basis. Our expertise includes asbestos and lead-based paint abatement, hazardous material removal, structural and interior demolition, debris removal, utility abandonment, site grading, and sod installation. **TAB – D: SCOPE OF SERVICES / TECHNICAL APPROACH**

Initiation of Demolition Project

1. PROPOSAL
 - a. Inspect project site and evaluate project. 2 DAYS
 - b. Develop material, equipment and manpower rates, including an estimate for the asbestos survey for the property. 1 DAY
 - c. Supply unit rates to establish total cost for the scope of work. 1 DAY
 - d. Provide proposal for Asbestos Survey and Demolition to Ft. Pierce. 1 DAY

2. ACCEPTANCE OF PROPOSAL AND ISSUANCE OF A NOTICE TO PROCEED
 - a. Mobilize to perform asbestos survey. 7 – 14 Days NOTE 1
 - b. Based on results from the survey, prepare asbestos abatement proposal if abatement is required. 2 DAYS
 - c. Following acceptance of proposal and notice to proceed, submit a ten-day DEP Notification for asbestos abatement and demolition activities. Initiate demo permitting submittals. 1 DAY
 - d. No abatement can proceed until the 10 days from filing has elapsed.
 - e. Abatement of asbestos containing materials (ACM's) generally 1-14 days depending on quantities of ACM present and the size of the structure to be demolished.
 - f. Perform pre-demo activities (rodent control, underground locates, and engage subcontractors if needed for the cuts and caps (HVAC, plumbing/septic, well etc. 10 DAYS NOTE 2
 - g. Upon receipt of the demolition permit from the local building department (timing unknown), mobilize to the site to begin demolition activities. 2-3 DAYS
 - h. Proceed to demolish the structure per the requirements of the notice to proceed. 2-14 DAYS depending on site conditions and structure size. Site to be left rough graded and free of all demolition debris.
 - i. Deliver final report including Daily Logs, visual inspections, final clearance certifications and Final Site photos. 7-14 DAYS

Note 1: Asbestos survey required for both abatement and demolition DEP notifications and permitting and must be the first item performed. CES pricing includes a third party Licensed Asbestos Consultant to perform the survey. PCM testing of bulk samples will be reported back in the survey report.

Note 2: A building department file review is part of the initial site inspection and evaluation. Data from this review plus information from the site underground locates gives the contractor a clearer understanding of the underground utilities and what needs to be cut and capped at the site, and what needs to be avoided to maintain utility operations for the surrounding areas.
