

RESOLUTION NO. 26-R43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA **RECEIVING AND ADOPTING THE PY 2026 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN** FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACTIVITIES DESCRIBED THEREIN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Pierce is an entitlement recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD regulations require the preparation and submission of an Annual Action Plan describing the activities and funding priorities to be undertaken during the program year; and

WHEREAS, the PY 2026 Annual Action Plan identifies the projects, activities, and estimated funding allocations proposed to address the priority needs established in the City's 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, the PY 2026 Annual Action Plan has been made available for public review and comment and has been the subject of public hearings conducted in accordance with applicable federal regulations and the City's Citizen Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that adoption of the PY 2026 Annual Action Plan is in the best interests of the City and its residents and will assist in addressing identified community development and housing needs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF

THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1: The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce hereby receives and accepts the PY 2026 Annual Action Plan, attached at Exhibit A, for submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for review and approval.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
