

RESOLUTION NO. 26-R44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA **RECEIVING AND ADOPTING THE 2026-2030 CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN** FOR SUBMISSION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Pierce is an entitlement recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD regulations require participating jurisdictions to adopt and maintain a Citizen Participation Plan that provides for and encourages citizen participation in the development, implementation, and assessment of federally funded housing and community development programs; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared the 2026-2030 Citizen Participation Plan to ensure compliance with applicable federal regulations and to provide meaningful opportunities for public participation in the planning and administration of Community Development Block Grant activities; and

WHEREAS, the 2026-2030 Citizen Participation Plan has been made available for public review and comment in accordance with applicable federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that adoption of 2026-2030 Citizen Participation Plan is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Fort Pierce.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1: The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce hereby receives and accepts the 2026-2030 Citizen Participation Plan, attached at Exhibit A, for submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for review and approval.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
