

RESOLUTION NO. 26-R45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA **RECEIVING AND ACCEPTING THE 2026-2030 CONSOLIDATED PLAN** FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS AND ANY CERTIFICATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Pierce is an entitlement recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD regulations require entitlement communities to prepare and adopt a Consolidated Plan identifying priority housing, homeless, community development, and economic development needs and establishing strategies to address those needs over a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared the 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan in accordance with applicable federal requirements and based upon community needs assessments, stakeholder consultation, citizen participation, and public input; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Grants Administration Division asserts and confirms all certifications contained in the 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan and all other certification documents to accompany said Plan, attached as Exhibit A, are true and accurate; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan has been made available for public review and comment and has been the subject of public hearings conducted in accordance with applicable federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that adoption of the 2026–2030 Consolidated Plan is in the best interests of the City and its residents and will guide the use of federal resources to address identified community needs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1: The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce hereby receives and accepts the 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan, attached at Exhibit A.

Section 2: The City Commission authorizes the submission of the 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development

for review and approval.

Section 3: The Mayor is hereby designated and authorized to execute any documents and certifications required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for submission with the 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan, and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the term and conditions of the Plan.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
