**Measurements of the Wall:** 25ft x 58.5ft



**Mural Concept:** A Large-Scale Community Mural Concept Blending Faith, Nature, and Local Identity

**Benefits to the area:** This mural celebrates the identity and mission of St. Andrew's Episcopal Academy by bringing together students, faith, the arts, and the natural beauty of the Indian River Lagoon in a vibrant and inspiring composition. The Academy name is prominently displayed beneath a radiant sun, creating a welcoming focal point that reflects growth, opportunity, and community. Students are represented as an integral part of the scene, symbolizing curiosity, diversity, and the spirit of learning that defines the campus, with visual references to creativity through music and visual art, including a violin and painted canvas.

A modest cross, styled to reflect the campus church, reinforces the school's spiritual foundation. Native wildlife and marine life—including manatee, snook, redfish, finger mullet, spotted eagle ray, sawfish, and stone crab—highlight environmental stewardship and the Academy's marine science and environmental education initiatives, serving as a visual extension of hands-on learning and exploration.

Lush greenery, coastal elements, and dynamic water movement frame the mural and create depth and energy, resulting in a lasting visual landmark that strengthens campus pride, community connection, and student engagement.
