CONTESTING OF FINE/NON-COMPLIANCE

1. THE GRAVITY OR SERIOUSNESS OF THE VIOLATION: **Moderate.**

2. The permit application for the temporary trailer was rejected by the Engineering Dept. in October , 2021 and was finally closed in September, 2022 due to inactivity. The permit application for the Container already installed was rejected in the Planning Dept. in October 2019 and never received approval.**
