DEFINITIONS:

Written Briefing: Items that generally do not require a presentation or discussion by the staff or Council. On these items the staff is seeking direction from the Council or providing information in a written format.

Verbal Briefing: These items do not require written background information or are an update on items previously discussed by the Council.

- (5) The deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices. Sec. 551.076, Tex. Gov't Code.
- (6) Discussions or deliberations regarding commercial or financial information that the City has received from a business prospect that the City seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the City and with which the City is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect of the sort described in this provision. Sec. 551.087, Tex. Gov't Code.
- (7) Discussions, deliberations, votes, or other final action on matters related to the City's competitive activity, including information that would, if disclosed, give advantage to competitors or prospective competitors and is reasonably related to one or more of the following categories of information:
 - generation unit specific and portfolio fixed and variable costs, including forecasts of those costs, capital improvement plans for generation units, and generation unit operating characteristics and outage scheduling;
 - bidding and pricing information for purchased power, generation and fuel, and Electric Reliability Council of Texas bids, prices, offers, and related services and strategies;
 - effective fuel and purchased power agreements and fuel transportation arrangements and contracts:
 - risk management information, contracts, and strategies, including fuel hedging and storage;
 - plans, studies, proposals, and analyses for system improvements, additions, or sales, other than transmission and distribution system improvements inside the service area for which the public power utility is the sole certificated retail provider; and
 - customer billing, contract, and usage information, electric power pricing information, system load characteristics, and electric power marketing analyses and strategies. Sec. 551.086; Tex. Gov't Code; Sec. 552.133, Tex. Gov't Code]

1. Public Comments on Work Session Items

Item Title: Naming of New Library in West Garland

ISSUE

In March 2023, the Library Board heard a presentation by Library staff regarding the naming of the new library facility being constructed in west Garland.

OPTIONS

- 1. Approve the naming of the new library facility as West Garland Library.
- 2. Do not approve the new library facility as West Garland Library.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on feedback and formal approval by the Library Board on Monday, March 13, 2023, the recommendation is to name the new facility: West Garland Library.

BACKGROUND

The Walnut Creek Branch Library is being relocated and expanded to a new location at Hollabaugh Park and Recreation Center as part of the 2019 Bond Program. The new name, West Garland Library, follows the naming convention for other Garland Library locations (Central, North, and South) and allows for a fresh start for the new facility.

Item Title: Bond Refunding - Electric Utility System Commercial Paper Notes

Submitted By: Matt Watson, Finance Director **Strategic Focus Areas:** Sound Governance and Finances

ISSUE

Consider refunding approximately \$65 million of Electric Utility System Commercial Paper Notes, Series 2021. The purpose of this transaction is to refund a portion of variable rate commercial paper notes with fixed rate long-term debt.

OPTIONS

- 1. Authorize staff to refund approximately \$65 million of Electric Utility System Commercial paper Notes, Series 2021.
- 2. Do not approve the refunding transaction.

RECOMMENDATION

Unless otherwise directed by Council, this item will be scheduled for formal consideration at the August 1, 2023 Regular Meeting.

BACKGROUND

The Electric Utility Commercial Paper Program finances the construction of various capital improvement projects for the Electric Utility. Funding capacity of this variable rate program is \$150 million with approximately \$65 million of capital spending available for refunding with fixed rate long-term debt.

CONSIDERATION

The Refunding Bonds will be fixed rate debt with a 30-year amortization period. The average annual debt service is projected to be \$4.0 million for the life of the bonds, from 2024 through 2053. The projected interest rate is 4.46%. The exact amount of annual debt service and interest is subject to market conditions between now and the final pricing.

Democracy in Action

The American democratic experience is built upon the foundation of concerned and caring residents becoming actively involved in local government. Consistent with this principle, Garland's Charter provides for the City Council to utilize resident volunteers to assist in carrying out the many functions of municipal government by serving on the City's Advisory Boards and Commissions. Please give serious consideration to becoming more involved in helping make Garland the best city possible by applying to serve on a board or commission of your choice. For further information, call 972-205-2404.

Process For Selection

Board members are selected for twoyear terms by the City Council in August. Terms are usually staggered whereby at least half of the membership has board experience.

All applicants and incumbents must submit a Board and Commission Application form by July 1. Members of some boards must possess certain technical skills as specified by ordinance. All board and commission members must file a Code of Ethics Disclosure Form with the City Secretary.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance by mail after their appointment. Because vacancies may arise during the year, all applications are kept on file for one year.

Qualifications

The Garland Charter and Code of Ordinances establish certain qualifications

that must be met by members of boards and commissions. In addition to special qualifications for service, a board member must:

- have been a resident of the state of Texas for one year and of Garland for six months prior to the date of appointment.
- be a qualified voter at time of appointment.
- not be in arrears on City taxes, utility service charges or other obligations owed the city.
- have not been convicted of a felony.
- have not been convicted of a Class A misdemeanor.
- not be an adversary party to pending litigation against the City.

- Researches issues and makes recommendations to Council concerning the City's changing demographic composition and diverse needs

Garland Cultural Arts Commission

- · Consists of nine members
- Meets quarterly
- Advises on policies of the Arts Center, negotiates contracts for usage of Heritage Park, awards grants to arts groups, and promotes the arts in general

Garland Youth Council

- Consists of 20 members; all high school age
- · One-year terms
- · Meets second Tuesday of every month
- Advises Council of wants and needs of Garland youth and acts as ambassadors for the City of Garland

Library Board

- · Consists of nine members
- · Meets second Monday of every month
- Advises Council on library services and programs
